SENATE BILL No. 246

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 34-28-8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2011]:

4 **Chapter 8. Class Actions**

5 **Sec. 1. A class action may not be brought or maintained on**
6 **behalf of a person who has not affirmatively agreed to be a party**
7 **to the class action.**
