DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Office of minority health. Provides that the director of the office of minority health reports to the state health commissioner. (Currently the director could report to an appointed assistant commissioner.)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-19-14-6, AS ADDED BY P.L.38-2010,
- 2 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 6. (a) The state health commissioner shall appoint
- 4 individuals to staff the office, including:
- 5 (1) the director of the office; and
- 6 (2) any other employees that the state health commissioner
- 7 determines are necessary.
- 8 (b) The employees appointed under subsection (a)(2) shall report to
- 9 the director. The director shall report to ~~at least an appointed assistant~~
- 10 **the** commissioner.
- 11 (c) The director shall supervise the employees assigned to the office.
- 12 (d) The director shall oversee the administrative functions of the
- 13 office.
