DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-50-6-8.

Synopsis: Sentencing for crimes with a firearm. Provides that a person serving a sentence for a crime that involved the use of a firearm does not earn credit time.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

SENATE BILL No. 567

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-50-6-8, AS ADDED BY P.L.53-2005,
2 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. **(a)** A person serving a sentence of life
4 imprisonment without parole does not earn credit time under this
5 chapter.

6 **(b) A person serving a sentence for a crime that involved the use**
7 **of a firearm (as defined in IC 35-47-1-5) does not earn credit time**
8 **under this chapter.**
