DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 31-40-2-2.

Synopsis: Juvenile probation services fund. Requires the fiscal body of a county to appropriate money from the county supplemental juvenile probation services fund (fund) to: (1) pay the salaries or supplement the salaries of employees of the juvenile courts of the county; and (2) construct, equip, operate, or maintain juvenile court facilities in the county. Specifies that money in the fund may be used only at the request of a judge of the juvenile court of the county.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 31-40-2-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 2. (a) The fiscal body
 3 of the county shall appropriate money from the county supplemental
 4 juvenile probation services fund:
 5 (1) to the juvenile courts of the county for the use by the courts in
 6 supplementing probation services to juveniles; ~~and~~
 7 (2) to supplement the salaries of juvenile probation officers in
 8 accordance with the salary schedule set by the county fiscal body
 9 under IC 36-2-16.5;
 10 **(3) to:**
 11 **(A) pay the salaries; or**
 12 **(B) supplement the salaries;**
 13 **of any other employees of the juvenile courts of the county;**
 14 **and**
 15 **(4) to construct, equip, operate, or maintain juvenile court**
 16 **facilities in the county, including courtrooms, offices,**
 17 **detention facilities, and shelter care facilities.**



1 (b) Money in the county supplemental juvenile probation services
2 fund may be used only:
3 (1) for supplementing probation services and to supplement the
4 salaries of probation officers in accordance with IC 31-31-5; the
5 purposes described in subsection (a); and
6 (2) at the request of a judge of the juvenile court of the
7 county.
