# HOUSE BILL No. 1175

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 7.1-3-10-14.

**Synopsis:** Alcohol displays. Requires a holder of a liquor dealer permit, other than a package liquor store, to display liquor for sale in a room or partitioned area separate from other retail items for sale on the premises. Prohibits a minor from entering the room or partitioned area without a parent or guardian who is at least 21 years of age.

**Effective:** July 1, 2011.

# HOUSE BILL No. 1175



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-10-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2011]: **Sec. 14. (a) This section does not apply to a package liquor  
4 store.**

5 **(b) A holder of a liquor dealer permit must display liquor for  
6 sale in a room or partitioned area that is separate from other retail  
7 items for sale on the premises. However, other alcoholic beverages  
8 may be displayed in the same room or partitioned area in which  
9 liquor is displayed under this subsection.**

10 **(c) A minor may not enter the room or partitioned area  
11 described in subsection (b) without a parent or guardian who is at  
12 least twenty-one (21) years of age.**

13 **(d) The commission shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to  
14 implement this section.**
