DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: Collection of sales tax from out-of-state vendors. Provides appropriations for the state to pursue enactment of the federal Main Street Fairness Act.

Effective: July 1, 2010 (retroactive).

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HOUSE BILL No. 1300



A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning taxation and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010 (RETROACTIVE)] (a)
2 As used in this SECTION, "Main Street Fairness Act" refers to
3 H.R.5660 introduced in the United States House of Representatives
4 on July 1, 2010, or another legislative resolution or bill with
5 equivalent language.
6 (b) In addition to the appropriations made in P.L.182-2009(ss),
7 SECTION 3 for the legislative council and legislative services
8 agency legislator and lay member travel total operating expenses,
9 there is appropriated ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) from the state
10 general fund to the legislative council and legislative services
11 agency for the purpose of paying travel expenses and other
12 ordinary and necessary expenses, including legislative business per
13 diem allowances, for members of the general assembly to meet with
14 members of the United States Congress to pursue passage of the
15 Main Street Fairness Act, beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June
16 30, 2011. The purposes for which the appropriation made under
17 this subsection may be used include expenditures related to



1 conducting meetings and hosting members of the United States
2 Congress in Indianapolis to pursue passage of the Main Street
3 Fairness Act. The policies and procedures that apply to
4 expenditures under P.L.182-2009(ss), SECTION 3 for legislator
5 travel apply to expenditures from an appropriation under this
6 subsection.

7 (c) In addition to the appropriations made in P.L.182-2009(ss),
8 SECTION 3 for the Washington liaison office for total operating
9 expenses, there is appropriated twenty-five thousand dollars
10 (\$25,000) from the state general fund to the Washington liaison
11 office to pursue passage of the Main Street Fairness Act, beginning
12 July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2011.

13 (d) Notwithstanding IC 4-13-2-19, an appropriation under this
14 SECTION that remains unexpended and unencumbered at the
15 close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, does not lapse and
16 revert to the general revenue fund but remains available in the
17 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, for the
18 purposes of the appropriation. The amount that remains available
19 for expenditure under this subsection shall be treated as
20 supplemental to any other money appropriated for the legislative
21 council and legislative services agency or the Washington liaison
22 office by any other act enacted in 2011, 2012, or 2013.

23 (e) This SECTION expires July 1, 2013.
24 SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.

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
