# HOUSE BILL No. 1342

## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-14-5.

**Synopsis:** Parking placards. Requires that a parking placard issued by the bureau of motor vehicles to an individual with a physical disability must contain the final four digits of the unique identification number displayed on the individual's driver's license or identification card. Makes it a Class C misdemeanor for a person other than the person to whom a parking placard is issued to use the parking placard to park in a parking space for persons with physical disabilities.

**Effective:** July 1, 2011.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1342



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-14-5-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 3. The placard required under  
3 section 1 of this chapter must contain the following:

- 4 (1) The words "Parking Permit for Persons with Physical  
5 Disabilities".
- 6 (2) An expiration date.
- 7 **(3) The final four (4) digits of the unique identification**  
8 **number displayed on:**
  - 9 **(A) the driver's license of; or**
  - 10 **(B) the identification card issued under IC 9-24-16 to;**  
11 **the individual to whom the placard is issued.**

12 SECTION 2. IC 9-14-5-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
13 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 9. (a) A person who knowingly and  
14 falsely represents the person as having the qualifications to obtain a  
15 placard issued under this chapter commits a Class C misdemeanor.

- 16 **(b) A person who recklessly, knowingly, or intentionally:**  
17 **(1) uses a placard issued under this chapter to park in a**



1            parking space reserved for persons with physical disabilities;  
2            and  
3            (2) does not possess a driver's license or identification card  
4            issued under IC 9-24-16 on which is displayed a unique  
5            identification number that matches the digits printed on the  
6            placard under section 3(3) of this chapter;  
7            commits a Class C misdemeanor.
