

HOUSE BILL No. 1386

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 15-19-7.

Synopsis: Commercial feed certification. Allows the state chemist to adopt rules concerning the inspection, auditing, and certification of commercial feed manufacturers and distributors that export commercial feed. Provides that the rules must include a schedule of fees to cover the cost of the state chemist's inspection activities. Provides that the failure to pay the fees is a Class C infraction.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning agriculture and animals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 15-19-7-34.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: **Sec. 34.5. (a) The state chemist may**
4 **adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to inspect, audit, and certify**
5 **commercial feed manufactures and distributors that export**
6 **commercial feed.**

7 (b) **The rules adopted under this section may incorporate**
8 **existing standards that are applicable to a particular manufacturer**
9 **or distributor.**

10 (c) **The rules adopted under this section must include a schedule**
11 **of fees for all activities required under this section to inspect, audit,**
12 **and certify a commercial feed manufacturer or distributor.**

13 SECTION 2. IC 15-19-7-40, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2008,
14 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
15 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 40. A person commits a Class C infraction if the
16 person knowingly engages in any of the following:

17 (1) The manufacture or distribution of a commercial feed that is



- 1 adulterated or misbranded.
- 2 (2) The adulteration or misbranding of a commercial feed.
- 3 (3) The distribution of agricultural commodities, such as whole
- 4 seed, hay, straw, stover, silage, cobs, husks, and hulls, that are
- 5 adulterated within the meaning of section 29(1) of this chapter.
- 6 (4) The removal or disposal of a commercial feed in violation of
- 7 an order under section 38 or 39 of this chapter.
- 8 (5) The failure to obtain a commercial feed license under section
- 9 24 of this chapter.
- 10 (6) The failure to pay inspection fees or file reports as required by
- 11 section 30, ~~or~~ 31, **or 34.5** of this chapter.

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
