DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-38-3-13.

Synopsis: University compensation to legislators. Provides that a public college or university may not compensate a legislator under a contract, employment, or any other arrangement. Provides that this prohibition does not apply to compensation paid: (1) under a contract, employment, or any other arrangement that began before an individual became a legislator; or (2) for lecturing or teaching at the college or university. Provides that a violation of the restriction is a Class D felony.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

HOUSE BILL No. 1436



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning higher education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 21-38-3-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 2011]: **Sec. 13. (a) This section does not apply to the following:**
- 4 **(1) Compensation paid to an individual under a contract,**
- 5 **employment, or any other arrangement that began before the**
- 6 **individual became a member of the general assembly.**
- 7 **(2) Compensation paid to an individual for lecturing or**
- 8 **teaching at an educational institution, whether on a full-time,**
- 9 **a part-time, or an occasional basis.**
- 10 **(b) A state educational institution may not pay a legislator**
- 11 **under a contract, employment, or any other arrangement.**
- 12 **(c) A person who violates this section commits a Class D felony.**
