DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Lifetime senior hunting license. Establishes a resident senior "hunt for life" license for individuals who are at least 65 years of age.

Effective: July 1, 2011.

HOUSE BILL No. 1448



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 14-22-12-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.46-2010,
- 2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 1. (a) The department may issue the following
- 4 licenses and, except as provided in section 1.5 of this chapter and
- 5 subject to subsection (b), shall charge the following minimum license
- 6 fees to hunt, trap, or fish in Indiana:
- 7 (1) A resident yearly license to fish, eight dollars and seventy-five
- 8 cents (\$8.75).
- 9 (2) A resident yearly license to hunt, eight dollars and
- 10 seventy-five cents (\$8.75).
- 11 (3) A resident yearly license to hunt and fish, thirteen dollars and
- 12 seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 13 (4) A resident yearly license to trap, eight dollars and seventy-five
- 14 cents (\$8.75).
- 15 (5) A nonresident yearly license to fish, twenty-four dollars and
- 16 seventy-five cents (\$24.75).
- 17 (6) A nonresident yearly license to hunt, sixty dollars and



- 1 seventy-five cents (\$60.75).
- 2 (7) A nonresident yearly license to trap, one hundred seventeen
- 3 dollars and seventy-five cents (\$117.75). However, a license may
- 4 not be issued to a resident of another state if that state does not
- 5 give reciprocity rights to Indiana residents similar to those
- 6 nonresident trapping privileges extended in Indiana.
- 7 (8) A resident or nonresident license to fish, including for trout
- 8 and salmon, for one (1) day only, four dollars and seventy-five
- 9 cents (\$4.75).
- 10 (9) A nonresident license to fish, excluding for trout and salmon,
- 11 for seven (7) days only, twelve dollars and seventy-five cents
- 12 (\$12.75).
- 13 (10) A nonresident license to hunt for five (5) consecutive days
- 14 only, twenty-five dollars and seventy-five cents (\$25.75).
- 15 (11) A resident or nonresident yearly stamp to fish for trout and
- 16 salmon, six dollars and seventy-five cents (\$6.75).
- 17 (12) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,
- 18 muzzle loading gun, rifle, or handgun, thirteen dollars and
- 19 seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 20 (13) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a muzzle loading
- 21 gun, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 22 (14) A resident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and
- 23 arrow, thirteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$13.75).
- 24 (15) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a shotgun,
- 25 muzzle loading gun, rifle, or handgun, one hundred twenty dollars
- 26 and seventy-five cents (\$120.75).
- 27 (16) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a muzzle
- 28 loading gun, one hundred twenty dollars and seventy-five cents
- 29 (\$120.75).
- 30 (17) A nonresident yearly license to take a deer with a bow and
- 31 arrow, one hundred twenty dollars and seventy-five cents
- 32 (\$120.75).
- 33 (18) A resident license to take an extra deer by a means, in a
- 34 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the
- 35 department under IC 4-22-2, five dollars (\$5).
- 36 (19) A nonresident license to take an extra deer by a means, in a
- 37 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the
- 38 department under IC 4-22-2, ten dollars (\$10).
- 39 (20) A resident yearly license to take a turkey, fourteen dollars
- 40 and seventy-five cents (\$14.75).
- 41 (21) A nonresident yearly license to take a turkey, one hundred
- 42 fourteen dollars and seventy-five cents (\$114.75). However, if the

1 state of residence of the nonresident applicant requires that before
 2 a resident of Indiana may take turkey in that state the resident of
 3 Indiana must also purchase another license in addition to a
 4 nonresident license to take turkey, the applicant must also
 5 purchase a nonresident yearly license to hunt under this section.
 6 (22) A resident license to take an extra turkey by a means, in a
 7 location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by the
 8 department under IC 4-22-2, fourteen dollars and seventy-five
 9 cents (\$14.75).
 10 (23) A nonresident license to take an extra turkey by a means, in
 11 a location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by
 12 the department under IC 4-22-2, one hundred fourteen dollars and
 13 seventy-five cents (\$114.75). However, if the state of residence of
 14 the nonresident applicant requires that before a resident of
 15 Indiana may take a turkey in that state the resident of Indiana
 16 must also purchase another license in addition to a nonresident
 17 license to take a turkey, the applicant must also purchase a
 18 nonresident yearly license to hunt under this section.
 19 (24) A resident youth yearly consolidated license to hunt, trap,
 20 and fish, six dollars (\$6). This license is subject to the following:
 21 (A) An applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.
 22 (B) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to hunt,
 23 trap, and fish and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits
 24 to hunt, trap, and fish for a specific species or by a specific
 25 means.
 26 (25) A nonresident youth yearly license to hunt, seventeen dollars
 27 (\$17). The applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.
 28 (26) A nonresident youth yearly license to trap, seventeen dollars
 29 (\$17). The applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.
 30 (27) A nonresident youth yearly license to take a turkey,
 31 twenty-five dollars (\$25). The applicant must be less than
 32 eighteen (18) years of age. However, if the state of residence of
 33 the nonresident applicant requires that before a resident of
 34 Indiana may take a turkey in that state the resident of Indiana
 35 must also purchase another license in addition to a nonresident
 36 license to take a turkey, the applicant must also purchase a
 37 nonresident youth yearly license to hunt under this section.
 38 (28) A nonresident youth license to take an extra turkey by a
 39 means, in a location, and under conditions established by rule
 40 adopted by the department under IC 4-22-2, twenty-five dollars
 41 (\$25). The applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.
 42 However, if the state of residence of the nonresident applicant

6 (29) A nonresident youth yearly license to take a deer with a
 7 shotgun, muzzle loading gun, or rifle, twenty-four dollars (\$24).
 8 The applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.

9 (30) A nonresident youth yearly license to take a deer with a
 10 muzzle loading gun, twenty-four dollars (\$24). The applicant
 11 must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.

12 (31) A nonresident youth yearly license to take a deer with a bow
 13 and arrow, twenty-four dollars (\$24). The applicant must be less
 14 than eighteen (18) years of age.

15 (32) A nonresident youth license to take an extra deer by a means,
 16 in a location, and under conditions established by rule adopted by
 17 the department under IC 4-22-2, twenty-four dollars (\$24). The
 18 applicant must be less than eighteen (18) years of age.

19 (33) A resident senior yearly license to fish, three dollars (\$3).
 20 This license is subject to the following:

21 (A) An applicant must be at least sixty-four (64) years of age
 22 and born after March 31, 1943.

23 (B) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to fish
 24 and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to fish for a
 25 specific species or by a specific means.

26 (34) A resident senior "fish for life" license, seventeen dollars
 27 (\$17). This license is subject to the following:

28 (A) An applicant must be at least sixty-four (64) years of age
 29 and must have been born after March 31, 1943.

30 (B) The license applies each year for the remainder of the
 31 license holder's life.

32 (C) The license is in lieu of the resident senior yearly license
 33 to fish and all other yearly licenses, stamps, or permits to fish
 34 for a specific species or by a specific means.

35 (35) A voluntary resident senior yearly license to fish, three
 36 dollars (\$3). This license is subject to the following:

37 (A) An applicant must have been born before April 1, 1943.

38 (B) The license is instead of the resident yearly license to fish
 39 and all other yearly licenses, stamps, and permits to fish for a
 40 specific species or by a specific means.

41 **(36) A resident senior "hunt for life" license, seventeen dollars**
 42 **(\$17). This license is subject to the following:**

- 1 **(A) An applicant must be at least sixty-five (65) years of**
- 2 **age.**
- 3 **(B) The applicant is a resident of Indiana.**
- 4 **(C) The license applies each year for the remainder of the**
- 5 **license holder's life.**
- 6 **(D) The license is in lieu of the resident yearly license to**
- 7 **hunt.**
- 8 (b) The commission may set license fees to hunt, trap, or fish above
- 9 the minimum fees established under subsection (a).
- 10 (c) In addition to the license fees set under this section, the
- 11 department shall establish a procedure to collect voluntary donations
- 12 for processing wild game when a hunting license is sold. The minimum
- 13 suggested donation must be one dollar (\$1). The money collected under
- 14 this section shall be deposited in the Indiana sportsmen's benevolence
- 15 account (IC 14-9-5-4).
