Synopsis: Public work projects. Authorizes a board to enter into a construction management at risk agreement for a public work project for which the cost will be at least \$25,000,000.

HOUSE BILL No. 1542



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-12-22 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 3 1, 2011]: **Sec. 22. (a) As used in this section, "construction
 4 management at risk" means a project delivery method in which:**
 5 (1) **design and construction are addressed in two (2) separate
 6 contracts; and**
 7 (2) **the selection criteria include other factors in addition to
 8 lowest responsible and responsive bid.**
 9 (b) **Notwithstanding any other law, the board may enter into a
 10 construction management at risk agreement for a public work
 11 project for which the cost will be at least twenty-five million dollars
 12 (\$25,000,000).**
