DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-43-5-10.

Synopsis: Dual college credit program. Allows the commission for higher education to set a cap on student fees for courses taken under the double up for college program and taught by high school teachers in a high school setting.

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HOUSE BILL No. 1575

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 21-43-5-10, AS ADDED BY P.L.234-2007,
2 SECTION 66, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 10. **(a) The commission for higher education
4 may set a cap on student fees for courses taken under this program
5 and taught by high school teachers in a high school setting.**
6 **(b)** A state educational institution may grant financial assistance,
7 including a waiver of tuition not otherwise covered by IC 21-14-8, to
8 a student for courses taken under this program based on:
9 (1) the student's financial need;
10 (2) the student's academic achievement; or
11 (3) any other criteria.
