

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1058 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:

24 **lifetime", for purposes of IC 12-10-2.5, has the meaning set forth**
25 **in IC 12-10-2.5-2.**
26 SECTION 3. IC 12-10-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
27 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
28 UPON PASSAGE]:
29 **Chapter 2.5. Hoosier Commission for Communities for a**
30 **Lifetime**
31 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "commission" refers to the**
32 **Hoosier commission for communities for a lifetime established by**

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section 3 of this chapter.

Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "community for a lifetime" refers to a community where residents work together in holistic and multidisciplinary ways to allow residents to:

- (1) organize and become involved in the community;**
- (2) decide collectively on the priorities for the community;**
- and**
- (3) act on the priorities to implement change in the community.**

Sec. 3. (a) The Hoosier commission for communities for a lifetime is established to report to the general assembly with recommendations on the following:

- (1) A process for a community to request and receive the designation of Hoosier community for a lifetime.**
 - (2) The resources needed, from all sectors, to:**
 - (A) initiate planning; and**
 - (B) implement plans;**
- in a community to become a community for a lifetime.**

(b) The commission consists of the following members to be appointed for a term ending December 31, 2012:

- (1) The executive director of the Indiana housing and community development authority created by IC 5-20-1-3, or the executive director's designee, who shall serve as the chairperson of the commission.**
- (2) The director of the division of aging established by IC 12-9.1-1-1, or the director's designee.**
- (3) Two (2) city officials, to be appointed as follows:**
 - (A) One (1) city official to be appointed by the minority leader of the senate.**
 - (B) One (1) city official to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
- (4) Two (2) county officials, to be appointed as follows:**
 - (A) One (1) county official to be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.**
 - (B) One (1) county official to be appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives.**
- (5) Four (4) representatives from area agencies on the aging, to be appointed as follows:**
 - (A) One (1) representative to be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.**
 - (B) One (1) representative to be appointed by the minority leader of the senate.**
 - (C) One (1) representative to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
 - (D) One (1) representative to be appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives.**
- (6) Two (2) health care representatives, to be appointed as follows:**
 - (A) One (1) individual to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
 - (B) One (1) individual to be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.**

- 1 **(7) Two (2) representative from universities, to be appointed**
 2 **as follows:**
- 3 **(A) One (1) individual to be appointed by the minority**
 4 **leader of the senate.**
- 5 **(B) One (1) individual to be appointed by the minority**
 6 **leader of the house of representatives.**
- 7 **(8) One (1) member who is:**
- 8 **(A) a member of a minority group (as defined in**
 9 **IC 4-13-16.5-1(j)); and**
- 10 **(B) a representative of a health care provider;**
 11 **to be appointed by the governor.**
- 12 **(9) One (1) representative of an agency involved in planning,**
 13 **housing, and economic development, to be appointed by the**
 14 **governor.**
- 15 **(10) One (1) representative from the business community, to**
 16 **be appointed by the governor.**
- 17 **(11) One (1) representative of the home building industry, to**
 18 **be appointed by the governor.**
- 19 **(12) One (1) member of the senate, to be appointed by the**
 20 **president pro tempore of the senate.**
- 21 **(13) One (1) member of the senate, to be appointed by the**
 22 **minority leader of the senate.**
- 23 **(14) One (1) member of the house of representatives, to be**
 24 **appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.**
- 25 **(15) One (1) member of the house of representatives, to be**
 26 **appointed by the minority leader of the house of**
 27 **representatives.**
- 28 **(16) One (1) Indiana resident who:**
- 29 **(A) is not more than fifty-nine (59) years of age; and**
 30 **(B) has a disability;**
 31 **to be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.**
- 32 **(17) One (1) Indiana resident who:**
- 33 **(A) is at least sixty-five (65) years of age; and**
 34 **(B) represents an aging advocacy organization;**
 35 **to be appointed by the speaker of the house of**
 36 **representatives.**
- 37 **(18) One (1) representative of the Indiana community**
 38 **foundation network, to be appointed by the governor.**
- 39 **(c) The commission shall be staffed by the Indiana housing and**
 40 **community development authority. Expenses of the commission**
 41 **shall be paid from appropriations made to the Indiana housing and**
 42 **community development authority.**
- 43 **Sec. 4. A member of the commission is not entitled to per diem**
 44 **or travel expenses incurred in attending commission meetings.**
- 45 **Sec. 5. The affirmative votes of a majority of the voting**
 46 **members appointed to the commission are required for the**
 47 **commission to take action on any measure, including preliminary**
 48 **and final reports.**
- 49 **Sec. 6. (a) When developing a plan for a community to become**
 50 **a community for a lifetime, the commission shall consider the**

- 1 following criteria:
- 2 (1) Affordable housing.
- 3 (2) Housing that is modified and constructed to
- 4 accommodate mobility issues and safety.
- 5 (3) Livability and safety, including a walkable environment
- 6 and complete streets.
- 7 (4) Access to nutritious food.
- 8 (5) Access to economic and wealth building opportunities.
- 9 (6) Home care and personal assistance services that residents
- 10 know how to obtain.
- 11 (7) Available retail services.
- 12 (8) Access to preventive health care.
- 13 (9) Opportunities for physical activity.
- 14 (10) Access to medical care.
- 15 (11) Access to affordable transportation.
- 16 (12) Available community services system.
- 17 (13) Mobilized caregivers to complement the formal service
- 18 system.
- 19 (14) Access to quality community or senior centers, nursing
- 20 homes, assisted living facilities, adult day care, and adult
- 21 foster care.
- 22 (15) Promotion of social and civic engagement.
- 23 (16) Access to meaningful relationships with children and
- 24 youth in the community.
- 25 (b) The commission shall consult with the Indiana Institute on
- 26 Disability and Community's Center on Aging and Community to
- 27 achieve the goals of the commission.
- 28 **Sec. 7. A community for a lifetime must do the following:**
- 29 (1) Involve partnerships among the state, regions, counties,
- 30 municipalities, cities, and towns where citizens seek to
- 31 affirmatively provide a high quality of life for all residents
- 32 and extend the opportunities, support, and services that will
- 33 enable citizens to grow older in a community of choice and
- 34 to continue to be contributing, civically engaged residents.
- 35 (2) Incorporate widespread citizen participation methods
- 36 into the local planning process.
- 37 (3) Establish an ongoing local commission to advise the
- 38 community on the opportunities, services, and supports
- 39 required by the citizens.
- 40 (4) Incorporate into the local plan elements addressing the
- 41 impact of changes in population demographics, including
- 42 age, land use, housing, public facilities, transportation, and
- 43 capital improvement.
- 44 (5) Develop strategies to develop infrastructure needed for
- 45 the projected population.
- 46 **Sec. 8. The commission shall make a preliminary report to the**
- 47 **general assembly not later than November 1, 2011. The commission**
- 48 **shall make a final report to the general assembly not later than**
- 49 **November 1, 2012. The reports to the general assembly must be in**
- 50 **an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.**

- 1 **Sec. 9. This chapter expires December 31, 2012."**
- 2 Page 2, after line 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 3 **"SECTION 6. An emergency is declared for this act."**
- 4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
