

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 112 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 4, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 8. IC 7.1-5-9-17 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
4 1, 2011]: **Sec. 17. (a) As used in this section, "beer and liquor
5 wholesaler" means a person who holds a beer wholesaler's permit
6 under IC 7.1-3-3 and a liquor wholesaler's permit under IC 7.1-3-8.
7 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, if the commission finds that
8 the granting of a beer and liquor wholesaler permit under this
9 chapter results in the displacement of any employee of an existing
10 beer wholesaler, the commission shall require the beer and liquor
11 wholesaler to pay each displaced employee an amount equivalent
12 to the unemployment benefit the displaced employee would
13 otherwise be entitled to receive under IC 22-4.
14 (c) Notwithstanding any other law, if the commission finds that
15 the granting of a beer and liquor wholesaler permit under this
16 chapter results in the displacement of any employee of an existing
17 beer wholesaler, the commission shall require the beer and liquor
18 wholesaler to pay the cost necessary for the displaced employee to
19 participate in the healthy Indiana check-up plan under
20 IC 12-15-44.2.
21 (d) Notwithstanding any other law, if the commission finds that
22 the granting of a beer and liquor wholesaler permit under this
23 chapter results in the closing of an existing beer wholesaler, the
24 commission shall require the beer and liquor wholesaler to pay to
25 the each political subdivision (as defined in IC 3-5-2-38) an amount**

- 1 **equivalent to the amount of taxes lost to the political subdivisions**
- 2 **as a result of the closing of the existing beer wholesaler."**
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
