

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 146 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 2, line 6, delete "death;" and insert "**death, unless a court**
2 **finds that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
3 **decedent's death;**".

4 Page 4, between lines 34 and 35, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5 "**(i) A spouse seeking a judicial determination under subsection**
6 **(a)(3)(A) that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
7 **decedent's death may petition the court having jurisdiction over**
8 **the dissolution or separation proceeding to make this**
9 **determination by filing the petition under the same cause number**
10 **as the dissolution or separation proceeding. A spouse who files a**
11 **petition under this subsection is not required to pay a filing fee.**".

12 Page 5, line 38, delete "death;" and insert "**death, unless a court**
13 **finds that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
14 **decedent's death;**".

15 Page 8, between lines 24 and 25, begin a new paragraph and insert:
16 "**(i) A spouse seeking a judicial determination under subsection**
17 **(a)(1)(C)(i) that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
18 **decedent's death may petition the court having jurisdiction over**
19 **the dissolution or separation proceeding to make this**
20 **determination by filing the petition under the same cause number**
21 **as the dissolution or separation proceeding. A spouse who files a**
22 **petition under this subsection is not required to pay a filing fee.**".

23 Page 9, line 11, delete "death;" and insert "**death, unless a court**
24 **finds that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
25 **decedent's death;**".

26 Page 11, between lines 39 and 40, begin a new paragraph and insert:
27 "**(j) A spouse seeking a judicial determination under subsection**
28 **(a)(3)(A) that the decedent and spouse were reconciled before the**
29 **decedent's death may petition the court having jurisdiction over**
30 **the dissolution or separation proceeding to make this**

1 **determination by filing the petition under the same cause number**
2 **as the dissolution or separation proceeding. A spouse who files a**
3 **petition under this subsection is not required to pay a filing fee."**
