

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 227, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and
2 insert:
3 "SECTION 207. IC 21-12-6-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.3-2008,
4 SECTION 131, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
5 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 5. (a) To qualify to participate in
6 the program, a student must meet the following requirements:
7 (1) Be a resident of Indiana.
8 (2) Be:
9 (A) enrolled in ~~grade 7 or 8 for the 2007-2008 school year and~~
10 grade 6, 7, or 8 for the 2008-2009 school year and for
11 subsequent school years, at a:
12 (i) public school; or
13 (ii) nonpublic school that is accredited either by the state
14 board of education or by a national or regional accrediting
15 agency whose accreditation is accepted as a school
16 improvement plan under IC 20-31-4-2; or
17 (B) otherwise qualified under the rules of the commission that
18 are adopted under IC 21-11-9-4 to include students who are in
19 grades other than grade 8 as eligible students.
20 (3) Be eligible for free or reduced priced lunches under the
21 national school lunch program.
22 (4) Agree, in writing, together with the student's custodial parents
23 or guardian, that the student will:
24 (A) graduate from a secondary school located in Indiana that
25 meets the admission criteria of an eligible institution;
26 (B) not illegally use controlled substances (as defined in
27 IC 35-48-1-9);
28 (C) not commit a crime or an infraction described in
29 IC 9-30-5;
30 (D) not commit any other crime or delinquent act (as described

- 1 in IC 31-37-1-2 or IC 31-37-2-2 through IC 31-37-2-5 (or
 2 IC 31-6-4-1(a)(1) through IC 31-6-4-1(a)(5) before their
 3 repeal));
 4 (E) timely apply, when the eligible student is a senior in high
 5 school:
 6 (i) for admission to an eligible institution; and
 7 (ii) for any federal and state student financial assistance
 8 available to the eligible student to attend an eligible
 9 institution; and
 10 (F) achieve a cumulative grade point average upon graduation
 11 of at least:
 12 (i) 2.0 on a 4.0 grading scale (or its equivalent if another
 13 grading scale is used) for courses taken during grades 9, 10,
 14 11, and 12, **for a student entering grade 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or**
 15 **12 before the 2012-2013 school year; or**
 16 (ii) **3.0 on a 4.0 grading scale (or its equivalent if another**
 17 **grading scale is used) for courses taken during grades 9,**
 18 **10, 11, and 12, for a student not covered by item (i).**
 19 (b) A student is qualified to participate in the program if the student:
 20 (1) before or during grade 7 or grade 8, is placed by or with the
 21 consent of the department of child services, by a court order, or by
 22 a child placing agency in:
 23 (A) a foster family home;
 24 (B) the home of a relative or other unlicensed caretaker;
 25 (C) a child caring institution; or
 26 (D) a group home;
 27 (2) agrees in writing, together with the student's caseworker (as
 28 defined in IC 31-9-2-11), to the conditions set forth in subsection
 29 (a)(4); and
 30 (3) except as provided in subdivision (2), otherwise meets the
 31 requirements of subsection (a).
 32 SECTION 208. IC 21-12-6-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007,
 33 SECTION 253, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 34 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 7. A scholarship may be renewed.
 35 To qualify for a scholarship renewal, a scholarship recipient must do
 36 the following:
 37 (1) Submit to the commission a renewal application that contains
 38 all the information and evidence required by the commission to
 39 determine eligibility for the scholarship renewal.
 40 (2) Continue to be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing
 41 at an eligible institution.
 42 (3) **Maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0**
 43 **on a 4.0 grading scale or its equivalent as established by the**
 44 **eligible institution, if the student initially enrolls in an eligible**
 45 **institution for a semester (or its equivalent) beginning after**
 46 **June 30, 2011.**

- 1 ~~(3)~~ (4) Continue to meet any other minimum criteria established
- 2 by the commission."
- 3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
