

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1001 be amended to read as follows:

1 Page 62, line 9, delete "44,053,605" and insert "**48,765,643**".
2 Page 62, delete lines 14 through 18, begin a new line blocked left
3 and insert:
4 **"The foregoing appropriations for C.H.O.I.C.E. In-Home Services**
5 **include intragovernmental transfers to provide the nonfederal**
6 **share of the Medicaid aged and disabled waiver. The**
7 **intragovernmental transfers for use in the Medicaid aged and**
8 **disabled waiver may not exceed in the state fiscal year beginning**
9 **July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2012, \$12,900,000. The**
10 **intragovernmental transfers for use in the Medicaid aged and**
11 **disabled waiver may not exceed in the state fiscal year beginning**
12 **July 1, 2012, and ending June 30, 2013, \$12,900,000. After July 1,**
13 **2011, and before August 1, 2012, the office of the secretary (as**
14 **defined in IC 12-7-2-135) shall submit a report to the legislative**
15 **council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 and the governor**
16 **in each July, October, January, and April specifying the number**
17 **of persons on the waiting list for C.H.O.I.C.E. In-Home Services at**
18 **the end of the month preceding the date of the report, a schedule**
19 **indicating the length of time persons have been on the waiting list,**
20 **a description of the conditions or problems that contribute to the**
21 **waiting list, the plan in the next six (6) months after the end of the**

1 **reporting period to reduce the waiting list, and any other**
2 **information that is necessary or appropriate to interpret the**
3 **information provided in the report."**
