

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1273 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 17, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 19. IC 25-35.6-1-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.197-2007,
3 SECTION 91, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. (a) The board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2
5 to define the role of support personnel, including the following:
6 (1) Supervisory responsibilities of the speech-language
7 pathologist.
8 (2) Ratio of support personnel to speech-language pathologists.
9 (3) Scope of duties and restrictions of responsibilities for each
10 type of support personnel.
11 (4) Frequency, duration, and documentation of supervision.
12 (5) Education and training required to perform services.
13 (6) Procedures for renewing registration and terminating duties.
14 (b) A speech-language pathologist must meet the following
15 qualifications to supervise speech-language pathology support
16 personnel:
17 (1) Hold a current license as a speech-language pathologist issued
18 by the board.
19 ~~(2) Have at least three (3) years of clinical experience.~~
20 ~~(3) (2) Except for an individual who:~~
21 (A) before September 1, 1990, completed all the course
22 work and obtained all the experience required to receive a
23 life license from the department of education; and
24 (B) was issued a life license by the department of
25 education;
26 hold a certificate of clinical competence in speech-language
27 pathology or its equivalent issued by a nationally recognized
28 association for speech-language and hearing.
29 (c) Speech-language pathology support personnel may provide
30 support services only under the supervision of a speech-language

1 pathologist."

2 Page 29, between lines 34 and 35, begin a new paragraph and insert:

3 "SECTION 24. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010 (RETROACTIVE)] (a)
4 **Notwithstanding IC 25-35.6-1-8(b)(3), before amendment by this**
5 **act on July 1, 2011, a speech-language pathologist is not required**
6 **to hold a certificate of clinical competence in speech-language**
7 **pathology or its equivalent issued by a nationally recognized**
8 **association for speech-language and hearing to supervise**
9 **speech-language pathology support personnel.**

10 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2013.**

11 SECTION 25. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011] (a) **The Indiana**
12 **professional licensing agency shall issue a license in**
13 **speech-language pathology as follows:**

14 (1) **To each individual who applies for licensure and meets the**
15 **following qualifications:**

16 (A) **Holds a license in speech and hearing therapy issued by**
17 **the department of education.**

18 (B) **Has a master's degree in speech-language pathology or**
19 **a related discipline.**

20 (C) **Has been employed as a speech-language pathologist**
21 **for at least nine (9) months in the last five (5) years.**

22 (2) **To each individual who applies for licensure and meets all**
23 **of the following qualifications:**

24 (A) **Holds a license in speech-language pathology issued by**
25 **the department of education.**

26 (B) **Has:**

27 (i) **been employed as a speech-language pathologist for at**
28 **least nine (9) months in the last five (5) years; or**

29 (ii) **taken at least thirty-six (36) hours of continuing**
30 **education approved by the department of education or**
31 **the health professions bureau after December 31, 2007,**
32 **and before January 1, 2013.**

33 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2013.**

34 SECTION 26. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2010 (RETROACTIVE)] (a)
35 **880 IAC 1-2.1-9(i) is void.**

1 **(b) The publisher of the Indiana Administrative Code and**
2 **Indiana Register shall remove 880 IAC 1-2.1-9(i) from the Indiana**
3 **Administrative Code.**

4 **(c) This SECTION expires January 1, 2012."**
5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
