

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 323 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 1. IC 20-46-1-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.41-2010,
3 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 8. (a) Subject to this chapter, the governing body
5 of a school corporation may adopt a resolution to place a referendum
6 under this chapter on the ballot for either of the following purposes:
7 (1) The governing body of the school corporation determines that
8 it cannot, in a calendar year, carry out its public educational duty
9 unless it imposes a referendum tax levy under this chapter.
10 (2) The governing body of the school corporation determines that
11 a referendum tax levy under this chapter should be imposed to
12 replace property tax revenue that the school corporation will not
13 receive because of the application of the credit under
14 IC 6-1.1-20.6.
15 (b) The governing body of the school corporation shall certify a
16 copy of the resolution to the department of local government finance,
17 ~~and the~~ **including the language for the question required by section**
18 **11 of this chapter. The department of local government finance**
19 **shall review the language for compliance with section 11 of this**
20 **chapter and either approve or reject the language. The department**
21 **shall send its decision to the governing body of the school**
22 **corporation not more than ten (10) days after the resolution is**
23 **submitted to the department. If the language is approved, the**
24 **governing body of the school corporation shall certify a copy of the**
25 **resolution, including the language for the question and the**
26 **department's approval, to:**
27 **(1) the county fiscal body (for informational purposes only);**
28 **and**
29 **(2) the circuit court clerk;**
30 of each county in which the school corporation is located."
