

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1137 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 28, delete "from the Dickey Road intersection to a" and
- 2 insert "**at an intersection approximately thirty hundredths (.30) of**
- 3 **a mile southwest of the intersection of Dickey Road and Riley Road**
- 4 **in East Chicago. The total gross weight, with load, of a vehicle or**
- 5 **combination of vehicles operated with a special weight permit on**
- 6 **this highway may not exceed two hundred sixty-four thousand**
- 7 **(264,000) pounds.**
- 8 SECTION 2. IC 9-20-5-5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.134-2007,
- 9 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 10 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5. **(a) Except as provided in subsection (b),**
- 11 the maximum size and weight limits for vehicles operated with a
- 12 special weight permit on an extra heavy duty highway are as follows:
- 13 (1) A vehicle may not have a maximum wheel weight, unladen or
- 14 with load, in excess of eight hundred (800) pounds per inch width
- 15 of tire, measured between the flanges of the rim.
- 16 (2) A single axle weight may not exceed eighteen thousand
- 17 (18,000) pounds.
- 18 (3) An axle in an axle combination may not exceed thirteen
- 19 thousand (13,000) pounds per axle, with the exception of one (1)
- 20 tandem group that may weigh sixteen thousand (16,000) pounds
- 21 per axle or a total of thirty-two thousand (32,000) pounds.
- 22 (4) Except as provided in section 4(22) of this chapter, the total
- 23 gross weight, with load, of any vehicle or combination of vehicles
- 24 may not exceed one hundred thirty-four thousand (134,000)
- 25 pounds.
- 26 (5) Axle spacings may not be less than three (3) feet, six (6)
- 27 inches, between each axle in an axle combination.
- 28 (6) Axle spacings may not be less than eight (8) feet between each
- 29 axle or axle combination.
- 30 **(b) A vehicle operated in accordance with section 4(23) of this**

- 1 **chapter may not have a:**
- 2 **(1) maximum wheel weight, unladen or with load, in excess of**
- 3 **one thousand six hundred fifty (1,650) pounds per inch width**
- 4 **of tire, measured between the flanges of the rim; or**
- 5 **(2) single axle weight that exceeds sixty-five thousand (65,000)**
- 6 **pounds."**
- 7 Page 2, delete lines 29 through 42.
- 8 Page 3, delete lines 1 through 23.
- 9 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
