DIGEST OF SB 4 (Updated January 20, 2011 2:07 pm - DI 104)

Citations Affected: IC 20-28.

Synopsis: Suicide prevention training for school personnel. Allows a governing body to adjourn its schools to allow teachers to participate in a basic or inservice course of education and training on suicide prevention and the recognition of signs that a student may be considering suicide. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the commission on mental health.)

Effective: July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-28-3-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.122-2007,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 4. A governing body may adjourn the governing
4 body's schools for not more than three (3) days in a school year to allow
5 teachers, school administrators, and paraprofessionals to participate in:
6 (1) a session concerning agricultural instruction conducted in the
7 county;
8 (2) a meeting of a teachers' association;
9 (3) a visitation of model schools under a governing body's
10 direction; ~~or~~
11 (4) a basic or inservice course of education and training on autism
12 that is certified by the state board in conjunction with the state
13 health commissioner and any other appropriate entity determined
14 by the state board; ~~or~~
15 **(5) a basic or inservice course of education and training on the**
16 **prevention of child suicide and the recognition of signs that a**
17 **student may be considering suicide.**
