

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Tax and Fiscal Policy, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 366, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 6, delete lines 32 through 42.
- 2 Page 7, delete line 1.
- 3 Page 9, line 27, after "attendance"" delete ",".
- 4 Page 10, line 2, after "services" delete ",".
- 5 Page 20, line 11, after "(c)" delete "," and insert "**or**".
- 6 Page 20, line 11, after "(d)" delete ",".
- 7 Page 20, line 11, after "or" insert "**as**".
- 8 Page 22, delete lines 8 through 20, begin a new paragraph and
- 9 insert:
- 10 "**Sec. 5. Any fees imposed under this chapter shall be deposited**
- 11 **in the lead trust fund established by IC 16-41-39.8-7.**
- 12 SECTION 39. IC 16-41-39.8-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.57-2009,
- 13 SECTION 17, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 14 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 7. (a) The lead trust fund established by
- 15 IC 13-17-14-6 (repealed) is reestablished to provide a source of money
- 16 for the purposes set forth in subsection (f).
- 17 (b) The expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from the
- 18 money in the fund.
- 19 (c) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not
- 20 currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same
- 21 manner as other public money may be invested. Interest that accrues

1 from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.

2 (d) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert
3 to the state general fund.

4 (e) The sources of money for the fund are the following:

5 (1) License fees established under section 6 of this chapter.

6 (2) Appropriations made by the general assembly, gifts, and
7 donations intended for deposit in the fund.

8 (3) Penalties imposed under sections 14 and 15 of this chapter for
9 violations of this chapter and rules adopted under this chapter
10 concerning lead-based paint activities.

11 **(4) Any fees imposed under the lead-based paint poisoning
12 prevention program under IC 16-41-39.2.**

13 **(5) Any gifts and grants to the fund.**

14 (f) The state department may use money in the fund to do the
15 following:

16 (1) Pay the expenses of administering this chapter.

17 (2) Cover other costs related to implementation of 40 CFR 745 for
18 lead-based paint activities in target housing and child occupied
19 facilities.

20 **(3) Administer the lead-based paint poisoning prevention
21 program set forth in IC 16-41-39.2."**

22 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
