

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Corrections, Criminal, and Civil Matters, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 411, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 10-14-3-33.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.90-2010,
4 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 JULY 1, 2011]: Sec. 33.5. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), the
6 state, a political subdivision, or any other person may not prohibit or
7 restrict the lawful possession, transfer, sale, transportation, storage,
8 display, or use of firearms or ammunition during:
9 (1) a disaster emergency;
10 (2) an energy emergency; or
11 (3) a local disaster emergency;
12 declared under this chapter.
13 (b) Subsection (a) does not authorize the possession, transfer, sale,
14 transportation, storage, display, or use of firearms or ammunition
15 during an emergency described in subsection (a):
16 (1) in or on school property, in or on property that is being used
17 by a school for a school function, or on a school bus in violation
18 of IC 20-33-8-16 or IC 35-47-9-2;
19 (2) on the property of:
20 (A) a child caring institution;

- 1 (B) an emergency shelter care child caring institution;
 2 (C) a private secure facility;
 3 (D) a group home; or
 4 (E) an emergency shelter care group home;
 5 in violation of 465 IAC 2-9-80, 465 IAC 2-10-79, 465
 6 IAC 2-11-80, 465 IAC 2-12-78, or 465 IAC 2-13-77;
 7 (3) on the property of a penal facility (as defined in
 8 IC 35-41-1-21);
 9 (4) in violation of federal law;
 10 (5) in or on property belonging to an approved postsecondary
 11 educational institution (as defined in IC 21-7-13-6(b));
 12 (6) on the property of a domestic violence shelter; **or**
 13 ~~(7) at a person's residence; or~~
 14 ~~(8)~~ (7) on property owned, operated, controlled, or used by an
 15 entity that:
 16 (A) is required to:
 17 (i) conduct a vulnerability assessment; and
 18 (ii) develop and implement a site security plan;
 19 under the United States Department of Homeland Security's
 20 Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards issued April 9,
 21 2007; or
 22 (B) is required to have a security plan under the Maritime
 23 Transportation Security Act of 2002, Public Law 107-295."
 24 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to SB 411 as introduced.)
