

# COMMITTEE REPORT

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

**The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 552, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:**

- 1           Page 2, line 6, delete "Subject" and insert "**Beginning January 1,**  
2           **2012, and subject**".
- 3           Page 2, line 7, delete "twenty-four (24) hours after birth".
- 4           Page 2, line 8, after "levels." insert "**Section 10(a)(2) of this**  
5           **chapter does not apply to this subsection. Funds from the newborn**  
6           **screening fund established in section 11 of this chapter may not be**  
7           **used to carry out this section.**".
- 8           Page 2, after line 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
9           "**SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011] (a) The state**  
10          **department of health shall do the following:**
- 11           **(1) Develop procedures and protocols for the implementation**  
12           **of IC 16-41-17-2(c), as amended by this act.**
- 13           **(2) Report, not later than October 31, 2011, to the legislative**  
14           **council created by IC 2-5-1.1-1 the following information**  
15           **concerning pulse oximetry screening of newborns required by**  
16           **IC 16-41-17-2(c), as amended by this act:**
- 17           **(A) The costs of implementing IC 16-41-17-2(c), as**  
18           **amended by this act.**
- 19           **(B) The identification of any funding sources available to**  
20           **the state department for the screening.**
- 21           **(C) The procedures and protocols developed under**

- 1                    **subdivision (1).**
- 2            **The report under subdivision (2) must be in an electronic format**
- 3            **under IC 5-14-6.**
- 4            **(b) This SECTION expires December 31, 2011."**  
              (Reference is to SB 552 as introduced.)

**and when so amended that said bill do pass.**
