

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Homeland Security, Transportation and Veterans Affairs, to which was referred House Bill No. 1334, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 4, between lines 8 and 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 7. IC 9-13-2-72.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
3 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
4 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 72.7. "High mounted stop
5 light" means a red stop lamp that:**
6 **(1) is mounted:**
7 **(A) on the rear of a motor vehicle;**
8 **(B) higher than other lamps mounted on the rear of the
9 motor vehicle; and**
10 **(C) on the vertical center line of the motor vehicle as
11 viewed from the rear; and**
12 **(2) when activated, emits a red light visible from a distance of
13 not less than one hundred (100) feet to the rear in normal
14 sunlight."**
15 Page 10, delete lines 34 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
16 insert:
17 "SECTION 25. IC 9-19-6-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
18 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 6. (a) This section
19 does not apply to a motorcycle or moped that is equipped with at
20 least one (1) stoplight meeting the requirements of section 17 of this**

1 **chapter. However, a motorcycle that was manufactured before**
 2 **January 1, 1956, is not required to be equipped with a stoplight**
 3 **meeting the requirements of section 17 of this chapter if the**
 4 **motorcycle is not operated during the times when the display of**
 5 **lighted head lamps or other illuminating devices is required under**
 6 **IC 9-21-7-2.**

7 (a) ~~Except as provided in subsection (b);~~ (b) A person may not:

8 (1) sell; or

9 (2) ~~drive~~ **operate** on the highways;

10 in Indiana a motor vehicle ~~including a motorcycle or motor-driven~~
 11 ~~cycle~~ unless the vehicle is equipped with at least ~~one (1) stoplight~~ **two**
 12 **(2) stoplights** meeting the requirements of section 17 of this chapter
 13 **and at least one (1) high mounted stoplight.**

14 (b) ~~A motorcycle manufactured before January 1, 1956, is not~~
 15 ~~required to be equipped with a stoplight under subsection (a) if the~~
 16 ~~motorcycle is not operated at the times when lighted head lamps and~~
 17 ~~other illuminating devices are required under IC 9-21-7-2.~~

18 (c) This subsection does not apply to a motorcycle or ~~motor-driven~~
 19 ~~cycle~~. **moped.** A person may not:

20 (1) sell;

21 (2) offer for sale; or

22 (3) operate on the highways;

23 a motor vehicle, trailer, or semitrailer registered in Indiana and
 24 manufactured or assembled after January 1, 1956, unless the vehicle is
 25 equipped with mechanical or electrical turn signals meeting the
 26 requirements of section 17 of this chapter.

27 (d) **This subsection applies to a passenger motor vehicle**
 28 **manufactured or assembled after January 1, 1986. A person may**
 29 **not:**

30 (1) sell;

31 (2) offer for sale; or

32 (3) operate on the highways;

33 **a passenger motor vehicle unless the vehicle is equipped with a**
 34 **high mounted stoplight."**

35 Page 11, delete lines 1 through 12.

36 Page 15, between lines 13 and 14, begin a new paragraph and insert:

37 "SECTION 35. IC 9-25-1-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

38 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY

1 1, 2011]: **Sec. 7. After June 30, 2011, this article applies to a moped**
2 **that is operated or driven on a highway."**

3 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1334 as reprinted February 15, 2011.)
