SENATE RESOLUTION No. 12

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

A SENATE RESOLUTION recognizing Falun Dafa practitioners.

Whereas, Falun Dafa, publicly introduced by Mr. Li Hongzhi in 1992, is now practiced and cherished by over 100 million people in over 100 countries, and has received a plethora of honors;

Whereas, Falun Dafa transcends cultural and racial boundaries, and contributes to the universal dream of a peaceful, tolerant, and more compassionate society;

Whereas, More men and women of the United States are learning the practice, purifying their hearts, energizing their bodies, and striving to create virtuous communities;
