**ENGROSSED
HOUSE BILL No. 1134**

DIGEST OF HB 1134 (Updated February 15, 2012 6:54 pm - DI 71)

Citations Affected: IC 20-27; IC 20-46.

Synopsis: Various education matters. Provides that no fee may be charged to a parent or student for transportation to and from school if a school corporation provides transportation or contracts with an educational service center to provide transportation. Specifies that a school corporation or educational service center may charge a fee for transportation to an athletic, a social, or another school sponsored function. Provides that parent supplemental transportation contracts do not apply to transportation provided by an educational service center. Provides that a school corporation that is required to provide transportation to a nonpublic student is required to provide the transportation to or from the point on the regular route that is nearest or most easily accessible to the nonpublic school from which the student can safely walk to and from the nonpublic school. Establishes the drive train and lubricant maintenance school bus life extension program. Provides that a governing body of a school corporation may elect to participate in the program by submitting an application to the department of local government finance. Provides that a governing

Provides that a governing body must submit an annual report with an annual drive train and lubricant report to justify the estimated cost savings to the governing body. Provides that the department of local government finance may approve, deny, or modify the annual application. Provides that the governing body must provide the department of local government finance any information that is necessary for the department to administer the program. Requires the department to establish criteria for calculating a governing body's cost savings. Makes technical corrections.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1134

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-27-5-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
2 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
3 2012]: Sec. 2. **(a)** The governing body of a school corporation may
4 provide transportation for students to and from school.

5 **(b) If the governing body of a school corporation:**

6 **(1) provides transportation; or**

7 **(2) contracts with an educational service center (as defined by**
8 **IC 20-20-1-2) to provide transportation;**

9 **no fee may be charged to a parent or student for transportation to**
10 **and from school. However, a fee may be charged for transportation**
11 **to and from an athletic, a social, or another school sponsored**
12 **function.**

13 SECTION 2. IC 20-27-6-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
14 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE APRIL 1,
15 2012]: Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to:

16 **(1) a nonpublic school or to a nonpublic school bus driver**
17 **contract executed for a nonpublic school; or**

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1 **(2) an educational service center (as defined by IC 20-20-1-2)**
 2 **or a school bus driver contract executed for an educational**
 3 **service center.**

4 SECTION 3. IC 20-27-11-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005,
 5 SECTION 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 6 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. (a) If a student who attends a nonpublic school
 7 in a school corporation resides on or along the highway constituting the
 8 regular route of a public school bus, the governing body of the school
 9 corporation shall provide transportation for the nonpublic school
 10 student on the school bus.

11 (b) The transportation provided under this section must be from the
 12 home of the nonpublic school student or from a point on the regular
 13 route nearest or most easily accessible to the home of the nonpublic
 14 school student to and from the nonpublic school or to and from the
 15 point on the regular route that is nearest or most easily accessible to the
 16 nonpublic school **from which the student can safely walk to and**
 17 **from the nonpublic school.**

18 SECTION 4. IC 20-46-5-12, AS ADDED BY P.L.234-2007,
 19 SECTION 264, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 20 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 12. (a) If:

21 (1) a school corporation enters into a lease agreement with the
 22 Indiana bond bank for the lease of one (1) or more school buses
 23 under IC 5-1.5-4-1(a)(5);

24 (2) the lease agreement conforms with the school corporation's ~~ten~~
 25 **(10) twelve (12)** year school bus replacement plan approved by
 26 the department of local government finance under section 9 of
 27 this chapter; and

28 (3) in the first full fiscal year after the effective date of the lease
 29 agreement, there would otherwise be a reduction in the levy in an
 30 amount equal to the difference between the total purchase price
 31 of the bus or buses and the total rental payment due under the
 32 lease agreement;

33 the levy in that fiscal year may not be reduced by the amount of the
 34 reduction.

35 (b) Any or all of the amount of that part of the levy may, on or
 36 before the end of the year of its collection, be:

37 (1) retained in the fund;

38 (2) transferred to the school transportation fund established under

40 (3) transferred to the capital projects fund established under

42 SECTION 5. IC 20-46-5-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

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1 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
2 JANUARY 1, 2013]: Sec. 13. (a) As used in this section,
3 "department" refers to the department of local government
4 finance.

5 (b) As used in this section, "participant" refers to a governing
6 body of a school corporation that elects to participate in the drive
7 train lubricant and cooling system fluids maintenance school bus
8 life extension program established under subsection (c).

9 (c) The drive train lubricant and cooling system fluids
10 maintenance school bus life extension program is established. A
11 participant who applies to participate in the program under
12 subsection (d) may be eligible to transfer an amount not to exceed
13 the estimated savings that result from the use of a school bus or
14 special use bus beyond the minimum useful life of the bus specified
15 in the governing body's plan under section 8 of this chapter. The
16 continued use of the bus must be justified with a drive train
17 lubricant and cooling system fluids annual report described in
18 subsection (e).

19 (d) A governing body may elect to participate in the program
20 established under subsection (c). To participate, a governing body
21 must submit an application to the department on forms provided
22 by the department.

23 (e) In addition to the application provided under subsection (d),
24 the governing body must submit an annual report to the
25 department, at a time specified by the department, that provides
26 an estimate of the cost savings to the governing body resulting
27 from extending the useful life of a school bus or special use bus
28 beyond the minimum useful life of the bus specified by the
29 governing body in its plan under section 8 of this chapter. The
30 estimate of cost savings must include an annual drive train
31 lubricants and cooling system fluids report that justifies that the
32 bus is in good working condition. The report must be in accordance
33 with ASTM standards.

34 (f) After a governing body submits its application and the
35 annual drive train lubricant and cooling system fluids report to the
36 department, the department may determine the amount the
37 governing body may transfer from the school corporation's fund
38 to the school corporation's general operating fund. A governing
39 body may transfer the amount determined by the department
40 under this subsection from the school corporation's fund to the
41 school corporation's general operating fund for the year specified
42 by the department.

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1 **(g) The department shall establish standard criteria to value the**
2 **cost savings to the governing body under this section. The**
3 **governing body's estimate of cost savings submitted to the**
4 **department under subsection (e) must be based on the standard**
5 **criteria established under this subsection.**
6 **(h) The department may request from the governing body any**
7 **information necessary to administer this section.**
8 **(i) The department may establish rules under IC 4-22-2 or**
9 **guidelines necessary to administer this section.**
10 **SECTION 6. An emergency is declared for this act.**

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COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Education, to which was referred House Bill 1134, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, between lines 10 and 11, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 2. IC 20-27-11-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. (a) If a student who attends a nonpublic school in a school corporation resides on or along the highway constituting the regular route of a public school bus, the governing body of the school corporation shall provide transportation for the nonpublic school student on the school bus.

(b) The transportation provided under this section must be from the home of the nonpublic school student or from a point on the regular route nearest or most easily accessible to the home of the nonpublic school student to and from the nonpublic school or to and from the point on the regular route that is nearest or most easily accessible to the nonpublic school **from which the student can safely walk to and from the nonpublic school.**"

Page 1, delete lines 11 through 17.

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 37.

Page 3, delete lines 20 through 42, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 3. IC 20-46-5-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2013]: **Sec. 13. (a) As used in this section, "department" refers to the department of local government finance.**

(b) As used in this section, "participant" refers to a governing body of a school corporation that elects to participate in the drive train and lubricant maintenance school bus life extension program established under subsection (c).

(c) The drive train and lubricant maintenance school bus life extension program is established. A participant who applies to participate in the program under subsection (d) may be eligible to transfer an amount not to exceed the estimated savings that result from the use of a school bus or special use bus beyond the minimum useful life of the bus specified in the governing body's plan under section 8 of this chapter. The continued use of the bus must be justified with a drive train and lubricant annual report described in subsection (e).

(d) A governing body may elect to participate in the program

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established under subsection (c). To participate, a governing body must submit an application to the department on forms provided by the department.

(e) In addition to the application provided under subsection (d), the governing body must submit an annual report to the department, at a time specified by the department, that provides an estimate of the cost savings to the governing body resulting from extending the useful life of a school bus or special use bus beyond the minimum useful life of the bus specified by the governing body in its plan under section 8 of this chapter. The estimate of cost savings must include an annual drive train lubricants and cooling system fluids report that justifies that the bus is in good working condition. The report must be in accordance with ASTM standards by an operator certified by the International Organization for Standardization.

(f) After a governing body submits its application and the annual drive train lubricant and cooling system fluids report to the department, the department may determine the amount the governing body may transfer from its fund to its general operating fund. A governing body may transfer the amount determined by the department under this subsection from its fund to its general operating fund for the year specified by the department.

(g) The department shall establish standard criteria to value the cost savings to the governing body under this section. The governing body's estimate of cost savings submitted to the department under subsection (e) must be based on the standard criteria established under this subsection.

(h) The department may request from the governing body any information necessary to administer this section.

(i) The department may establish rules under IC 4-22-2 or guidelines necessary to administer this section."
