MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 384 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 2. IC 20-19-3-11 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 3 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 4 1, 2012]: **Sec. 11. The department shall make reduction of**
- 5 **absenteeism in schools a policy priority and direct school**
- 6 **corporations and schools to:**
- 7 (1) **identify contributing factors of absenteeism; and**
- 8 (2) **develop chronic absence reduction plans.**
- 9 SECTION 3. IC 20-19-4-7, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
- 10 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
- 11 2012]: Sec. 7. (a) The roundtable shall **study and** provide
- 12 recommendations on subjects related to education, **including early**
- 13 **childhood education**, to the following:
- 14 (1) The governor.
- 15 (2) The state superintendent.
- 16 (3) The general assembly.
- 17 (4) The state board.
- 18 (b) The recommendations to the general assembly must be in an
- 19 electronic format under IC 5-14-6.
- 20 SECTION 4. IC 20-20-28-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005,
- 21 SECTION 4, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 22 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 4. (a) The department shall establish pilot
- 23 programs targeting at risk students in the following areas:
- 24 (1) Early childhood parental information programs.

- 1 (2) Latch key programs.
- 2 (3) Preschool programs.
- 3 (b) In establishing the pilot programs under this chapter, the
- 4 department shall focus on implementing programs that:
- 5 **(1) mirror proven early education programs; and**
- 6 **(2) enable the local school corporation and appropriate**
- 7 **community agencies to cooperate with each other.**
- 8 (c) The department shall address the following in establishing the
- 9 programs:
- 10 (1) Screening for physical health problems that can inhibit school
- 11 success.
- 12 (2) Screening for learning disabilities.
- 13 (3) Parental orientation and participation.
- 14 (d) In addition, the department shall employ an early childhood
- 15 specialist and support staff personnel to identify and determine ways
- 16 to coordinate the educational programs offered by local youth serving
- 17 organizations."

18 Page 4, between lines 1 and 2, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 19 "SECTION 6. IC 20-26-5-34 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 20 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 21 1, 2012]: **Sec. 34. School corporations shall share data on schools**
 22 **with a high number of chronic student absences with the**
 23 **department and with the office of the secretary of family and social**
 24 **services to:**

- 25 **(1) target allocation of resources; and**
- 26 **(2) identify or develop model programs to improve school**
- 27 **attendance.**

28 SECTION 7. IC 20-26-5-35 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 29 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 30 1, 2012]: **Sec. 35. The governing body of a school corporation may**
 31 **contract with a private or public entity to provide professional**
 32 **development activities to help teachers and administrators**
 33 **understand the factors contributing to chronic absences from**
 34 **school and how to address those factors."**

35 Page 14, between lines 3 and 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 36 "SECTION 27. IC 20-34-3-21 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
 37 CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 38 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 21. The governing body of a**
 39 **school corporation may contract with a nonprofit organization to**

1 **provide preventive and primary health care services in school**
2 **based clinics to students enrolled in schools within the school**
3 **corporation."**

4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
