HOUSE MOTION _____

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1004 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
- 2 paragraph and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. IC 3-6-4.2-12, AS AMENDED BY P.L.221-2005,
- 4 SECTION 8, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
- 5 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 12. The election division shall do the following:
- 6 (1) Maintain complete and uniform descriptions and maps of all
- 7 precincts in Indiana.
- 8 (2) Promptly update the information required by subdivision (1)
- 9 after each precinct establishment order is filed with the
- 10 commission under IC 3-11-1.5.
- 11 (3) Issue media watcher cards under IC 3-6-10-6.
- 12 (4) Prepare and transfer to the department of state revenue voter
- 13 registration affidavits for inclusion in state adjusted gross income
- 14 tax booklets under IC 6-8.1-3-19.
- 15 (5) Serve in accordance with 42 U.S.C. 1973ff-1(b) as the office
- 16 in Indiana responsible for providing information regarding voter
- 17 registration procedures and absentee ballot procedures to absent
- 18 uniformed services voters and overseas voters.
- 19 (6) As required by 42 U.S.C. 1973ff-1(c), submit a report to the
- 20 federal Election Assistance Commission not later than ninety (90)
- 21 days after each general election setting forth the combined
- 22 number of absentee ballots:
- 23 (A) transmitted to absent uniformed services voters and
- 24 overseas voters for the election; and

- 1 (B) returned by absent uniformed services voters and overseas
 2 voters and cast in the election.
- 3 (7) Implement the state plan in accordance with the requirements
 4 of HAVA (42 U.S.C. 15401 through 15406) and this title, and
 5 appoint members of the committee established under 42 U.S.C.
 6 15405.
- 7 (8) Submit reports required under 42 U.S.C. 15408 to the federal
 8 Election Assistance Commission concerning the use of federal
 9 funds under Title II, Subtitle D, Part I of HAVA.
- 10 **(9) Review and approve electronic poll list software,
 11 hardware, and firmware."**
- 12 Page 2, between lines 21 and 22, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 13 "SECTION 4. IC 3-11-8-10.3, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2011,
 14 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 15 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 10.3. (a) As used in this section, "electronic poll
 16 list" refers to a poll list that is maintained in a computer data base.
- 17 (b) An electronic poll list must satisfy all of the following:
- 18 (1) An electronic poll list must be programmed so that the
 19 coordinated action of two (2) election officers who are not
 20 members of the same political party is necessary to access the
 21 electronic poll list.
- 22 (2) An electronic poll list may not be connected to a voting
 23 system.
- 24 (3) An electronic poll list may not permit access to voter
 25 information other than information provided on the certified list
 26 of voters prepared under IC 3-7-29-1.
- 27 **(c) After December 31, 2012, any software used to operate an
 28 electronic poll list must be certified by the election division before
 29 the software may be used by a county in an election. Electronic poll
 30 list software used in Indiana before January 1, 2013, must be
 31 certified by the election division before the software may be used
 32 in an election held after December 31, 2012."**
- 33 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to HB 1004 as printed January 13, 2012.)
