# HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1059 be amended to read as follows:

1           Page 2, after line 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
2           "SECTION 2. IC 14-19-3-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.87-2010,  
3           SECTION 40, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
4           [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 4. (a) Upon application to the  
5           department, a resident of Indiana:  
6           (1) who  
7           (A) if born in 1933, 1934, 1935, 1936, or 1937, is at least sixty  
8           (60) years of age; or  
9           (B) if born before 1933 or after 1937, is at least sixty-five (65)  
10          years of age;  
11          (2) who is eligible for Social Security disability payments under  
12          42 U.S.C. 423;  
13          (3) who is eligible for a disabled Hoosier veteran license plate  
14          under IC 9-18-18-1; or  
15          (4) who is issued a prisoner of war license plate under  
16          IC 9-18-17-1; or  
17          (5) who:  
18                (A) served in:  
19                   (i) the armed forces of the United States or their  
20                   reserves; or  
21                   (ii) the National Guard; and  
22                (B) received an honorable discharge from service;  
23          may purchase or is eligible to receive an annual Golden Hoosier  
24          Passport.

- 1 (b) A Golden Hoosier Passport entitles:  
2 (1) the resident;  
3 (2) the resident's motor vehicle; and  
4 (3) the resident's passengers;  
5 to unlimited admission for one (1) calendar year to the Indiana state  
6 parks, recreation areas, reservoirs, forests, historic sites, museums,  
7 memorials, and other department properties for which admission is  
8 charged during the year for which the passport was issued.  
9 (c) Except as provided in subsection (d), the fee for an annual  
10 Golden Hoosier Passport issued under this section is fifty percent (50%)  
11 of the fee that the department charges a resident who is not described  
12 in subsection (a)(1), (a)(2), or (a)(3) for unlimited admission for one (1)  
13 calendar year to the Indiana state parks, recreation areas, reservoirs,  
14 forests, historic sites, museums, memorials, and other department  
15 properties for which admission is charged.  
16 (d) A fee may not be charged for an annual Golden Hoosier Passport  
17 issued under this section to a resident described in subsection (a)(4) or  
18 **(a)(5)**."
