MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1222 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 17, between lines 5 and 6, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 47. IC 9-18-25-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012 (RETROACTIVE)]:
- 4 Sec. 2. (a) **Except as provided in section 2.5 of this chapter**, the
- 5 bureau shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 establishing the requirements
- 6 to qualify for participation in the special group recognition license plate
- 7 program.
- 8 (b) Representatives of a special group shall petition the bureau to
- 9 qualify for participation in the special group recognition license plate
- 10 program.
- 11 (c) Each petition submitted under this section must contain the
- 12 printed name, address, and signature of at least five hundred (500)
- 13 members of the special group who pledge to purchase the special group
- 14 recognition license plate if a special group recognition license plate is
- 15 issued for the group under this chapter.
- 16 (d) When a petition containing the information required in
- 17 subsection (c) is submitted to the bureau, the bureau may design and
- 18 issue a special group recognition license plate that designates a vehicle
- 19 as being registered under this chapter by a person (as defined in
- 20 IC 9-13-2-124) who is a member of the special group.
- 21 SECTION 48. IC 9-18-25-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 22 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
- 23 [EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2012 (RETROACTIVE)]: **Sec. 2.5. (a)**
- 24 **Beginning January 1, 2012, the bureau may not approve, issue, or**

1 renew a special group recognition license plate issued under this
 2 chapter for a special group that encourages, supports, or promotes
 3 any of the following:

- 4 (1) Use of illegal drugs.
 5 (2) Use of tobacco or tobacco products by a minor.
 6 (3) Sexual activity involving a minor.
 7 (4) Sexual activity outside of marriage not in accordance with
 8 IC 20-30-5-13.
 9 (5) Use of pornography.
 10 (6) Abortion.
 11 (7) Disrespect for parents, the family, religion, healthy
 12 behavior, or good citizenship as described in:
 13 (A) IC 20-30-5-5; or
 14 (B) IC 20-30-5-6.
 15 (8) The undermining of the Constitution of the United States
 16 or the Constitution of the State of Indiana.
 17 (9) The:
 18 (A) undermining of the law; or
 19 (B) overthrow;
 20 of the government of the United States.
 21 (10) A lifestyle that is contrary to:
 22 (A) IC 20-30-5-13; or
 23 (B) marriage between one (1) man and one (1) woman.
 24 (11) The use of alcoholic beverages by an individual less than
 25 twenty-one (21) years of age.

26 (b) The bureau shall identify each special group that
 27 encourages, supports, or promotes any of the subjects set forth in
 28 subsection (a) and upon identification shall terminate the special
 29 group's eligibility within the special group recognition plate
 30 program. Upon termination of the eligibility, the bureau shall
 31 demand the return of the special group recognition license plate
 32 issued to each recipient of a license plate concerning the terminated
 33 special group. Upon return of the terminated special group
 34 recognition license plate, the bureau shall refund any:

- 35 (1) annual supplemental fee collected under IC 9-29-5-38(a)(2)
 36 or IC 9-29-5-38(d)(3); and
 37 (2) annual fee collected by the bureau under this article and
 38 IC 9-29-5 that has been distributed to any trust fund
 39 established under section 17.7 of this chapter;

40 to the former plateholder.

41 (c) The bureau shall:

- 42 (1) afford the former special group recognition plateholder
 43 the opportunity to submit an application to purchase another
 44 special group recognition license plate; or
 45 (2) issue a license plate in accordance with IC 9-18-2-30."

46 Page 86, after line 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:

47 "SECTION 86. An emergency is declared for this act."

- 1 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
