## HOUSE MOTION \_\_\_\_\_

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that House Bill 1247 be amended to read as follows:

- 1           Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new  
2 paragraph and insert:  
3           "SECTION 1. IC 9-13-2-196.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.58-2006,  
4 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
5 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 196.5. (a) "Veteran", for purposes of IC 9-18-50,  
6 has the meaning set forth in IC 9-18-50-1.  
7           **(b) "Veteran", for purposes of IC 9-18-55, has the meaning set**  
8 **forth in IC 9-18-55-1.**  
9           SECTION 2. IC 9-18-15-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.87-2010,  
10 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
11 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. (a) A person who is the registered owner or  
12 lessee of a:  
13           (1) passenger motor vehicle;  
14           (2) motorcycle;  
15           (3) recreational vehicle; or  
16           (4) vehicle registered as a truck with a declared gross weight of  
17 not more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds;  
18 registered with the bureau or who makes an application for an original  
19 registration or renewal registration of a vehicle may apply to the bureau  
20 for a personalized license plate to be affixed to the vehicle for which  
21 registration is sought instead of the regular license plate.  
22           (b) A person who:  
23           (1) is the registered owner or lessee of a vehicle described in  
24 subsection (a); and

- 1 (2) is eligible to receive a license plate for the vehicle under:  
 2 (A) IC 9-18-17 (prisoner of war license plates);  
 3 (B) IC 9-18-18 (disabled Hoosier veteran license plates);  
 4 (C) IC 9-18-19 (Purple Heart license plates);  
 5 (D) IC 9-18-20 (Indiana National Guard license plates);  
 6 (E) IC 9-18-21 (Indiana Guard Reserve license plates);  
 7 (F) IC 9-18-22 (license plates for persons with disabilities);  
 8 (G) IC 9-18-23 (amateur radio operator license plates);  
 9 (H) IC 9-18-24 (civic event license plates);  
 10 (I) IC 9-18-24.5 (In God We Trust license plates);  
 11 (J) IC 9-18-25 (special group recognition license plates);  
 12 (K) IC 9-18-29 (environmental license plates);  
 13 (L) IC 9-18-30 (kids first trust license plates);  
 14 (M) IC 9-18-31 (education license plates);

 44 **(KK) IC 9-18-55 (Vietnam veterans trust license plates);**  
 45 may apply to the bureau for a personalized license plate to be affixed  
 46 to the vehicle for which registration is sought instead of the regular

- 1 special recognition license plate.
- 2 SECTION 3. IC 9-18-25-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.87-2010,  
3 SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
4 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to the following:
- 5 (1) Antique motor vehicle license plates (IC 9-18-12).
  - 6 (2) Recovery vehicle license plates (IC 9-18-13).
  - 7 (3) Personalized license plates (IC 9-18-15).
  - 8 (4) Prisoner of war license plates (IC 9-18-17).
  - 9 (5) Disabled Hoosier veteran license plates (IC 9-18-18).
  - 10 (6) Purple Heart license plates (IC 9-18-19).
  - 11 (7) Indiana National Guard license plates (IC 9-18-20).
  - 12 (8) Person with a disability license plates (IC 9-18-22).
  - 13 (9) Amateur radio operator license plates (IC 9-18-23).
  - 14 (10) In God We Trust license plates (IC 9-18-24.5).
  - 15 (11) Pearl Harbor survivor license plates (IC 9-18-45.8).
  - 16 (12) Hoosier veteran license plates (IC 9-18-50).
  - 17 (13) Support our troops license plates (IC 9-18-51).

- 21 SECTION 4. IC 9-18-55 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS  
22 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
23 1, 2012]:
- 24 **Chapter 55. Vietnam Veterans Trust License Plates**
- 25 **Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "veteran" refers to an individual**  
26 **who has served as a member of the armed forces of the United**  
27 **States at any time from August 5, 1964, through May 7, 1975**  
28 **(Vietnam Conflict).**
- 29 **Sec. 2. The bureau shall design a Vietnam veterans trust license**  
30 **plate to be issued beginning January 1, 2013.**
- 31 **Sec. 3. A Vietnam veterans trust license plate must include the**  
32 **following:**
- 33 **(1) A basic design for the plate with consecutive numbers or**  
34 **letters, or both, to properly identify the vehicle.**
  - 35 **(2) A background design or colors that designate the license**  
36 **plate as a Vietnam veterans trust license plate.**
  - 37 **(3) Any other information the bureau considers necessary.**
- 38 **Sec. 4. The bureau shall confer with members of armed forces**  
39 **retiree organizations concerning the design of the Vietnam**  
40 **veterans trust license plate and the emblems denoting the branch**  
41 **of service or conflict in which the veteran served.**
- 42 **Sec. 5. A Vietnam veterans trust license plate issued under this**  
43 **chapter may be displayed on the following:**
- 44 **(1) A passenger motor vehicle.**
  - 45 **(2) A truck registered as a truck with a declared gross weight**  
46 **of not more than eleven thousand (11,000) pounds.**

- (3) A recreational vehicle.
  - (4) A motorcycle.
- Sec. 6. A veteran who is a resident of Indiana and eligible to register a vehicle listed in section 5 of this chapter may apply for and receive a Vietnam veterans trust license plate for one (1) or more vehicles upon doing the following:**
- (1) Completing an application for a Vietnam veterans trust license plate.
  - (2) Presenting:
    - (A) a United States Uniformed Services Retiree Identification Card;
    - (B) a DD 214 record;
    - (C) United States military discharge papers; or
    - (D) a current armed forces identification card;
 to the bureau.
  - (3) Paying the fees under section 7 of this chapter.
- Sec. 7. (a) The fees for a Vietnam veterans trust license plate are set forth in IC 9-29-5-38.7.**
- (b) The annual supplemental fee described in IC 9-29-5-38.7(a)(2) shall be:
    - (1) collected by the bureau; and
    - (2) deposited in the operation homefront trust fund established by section 8 of this chapter.
- Sec. 8. (a) The operation homefront trust fund is established.**
- (b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same manner as other public funds are invested. Interest that accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund. Money in the fund is continuously appropriated for the purposes of this section.
  - (c) The commissioner shall administer the fund. Expenses of administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.
  - (d) On June 30 of each year, the commissioner shall distribute the money from the fund to the Indiana chapter of Operation Homefront.
  - (e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not revert to the state general fund."
- Page 2, between lines 33 and 34, begin a new paragraph and insert:  
 "SECTION 6. IC 9-29-5-38.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 38.7. (a) A vehicle registered under IC 9-18-55 is subject to:**
- (1) an annual registration fee;
  - (2) an annual supplemental fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25); and
  - (3) any other fee or tax required of a person registering a vehicle under this title.
- (b) The bureau shall collect from each registration the annual

- 1 **supplemental fee described in subsection (a)(2).**
- 2 **(c) The bureau shall deposit the annual supplemental fee**
- 3 **described in subsection (a)(2) in the operation homefront trust**
- 4 **fund established under IC 9-18-55-8(a)."**
- 5 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
