## HOUSE BILL No. 1015

---

DIGEST OF HB 1015 (Updated January 20, 2012 12:40 pm - DI 107)

**Citations Affected:** IC 6-1.1; IC 14-8; IC 14-21; IC 34-30.

**Synopsis:** Cemetery access. Provides immunity from civil liability to landowners who grant a decedent's family members or invitees access to cemeteries that are located on the landowners' properties and subject to property tax assessment as cemetery lands. Provides immunity from civil liability to persons who guide family members or invitees to those cemeteries. Provides that a family member is allowed access to those cemeteries at least 3 days a year.

**Effective:** July 1, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning civil procedure.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 6-1.1-6.8-15 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY

**Chapter 5. Access to Cemetery Land**

**Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "family member" means a relative or descendant of a person buried in a cemetery.**

**Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "invitee" means an individual who has been given permission by a landowner to visit a cemetery located on the landowner's property.**

**Sec. 3. The owner of land that is classified under IC 6-1.1-6.8 as cemetery land must allow family members of persons buried in the cemetery at least three (3) days each year during which the family members may gain access to and visit the cemetery. The date or dates on which family members will visit the cemetery must be agreed upon between the landowner and the family members.**

**Sec. 4. The following apply when a landowner grants access to a cemetery that is classified under IC 6-1.1-6.8:**

**(1) Except for an injury that is a direct result of a landowner's gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct, the landowner is immune from civil liability for any injury occurring to the health, life, or property of an invitee or a family member during the time the invitee or family member is present on the landowner's property.**

**(2) Except for an injury that is a direct result of a guide's gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct, a person guiding an invitee or a family member to the cemetery is immune from civil liability for any injury occurring to the health, life, or property of the invitee or family member during the time the guide and the invitee or family member are present on the landowner's property.**

**SECTION 5. IC 34-30-2-55.8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 55.8. IC 14-21-5-4 (Concerning landowners, guides, and family members or descendants granted access to cemetery land under IC 14-21-5).**

## COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Speaker: Your Committee on Judiciary, to which was referred House Bill 1015, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. IC 6-1.1-6.8-15 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]. ~~Sec. 15. The owner of land that is classified under this chapter as cemetery land must allow family members and descendants of persons buried in the cemetery to have at least one (1) day each year to gain access to and visit the cemetery. The date of the visit to the cemetery must be agreed upon between the owner and the family members and descendants of persons buried in the cemetery.~~

SECTION 2. IC 14-8-2-87.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 87.6. "Family member", for purposes of IC 14-21-5, has the meaning set forth in IC 14-21-5-1.**

SECTION 3. IC 14-8-2-135.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 135.2. "Invitee", for purposes of IC 14-21-5, has the meaning set forth in IC 14-21-5-2.**

SECTION 4. IC 14-21-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]:

**Chapter 5. Access to Cemetery Land**

**Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "family member" means a relative or descendant of a person buried in a cemetery.**

**Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "invitee" means an individual who has been given permission by a landowner to visit a cemetery located on the landowner's property.**

**Sec. 3. The owner of land that is classified under IC 6-1.1-6.8 as cemetery land must allow family members of persons buried in the cemetery at least three (3) days each year during which the family members may gain access to and visit the cemetery. The date or dates on which family members will visit the cemetery must be agreed upon between the landowner and the family members.**

**Sec. 4. The following apply when a landowner grants access to a cemetery that is classified under IC 6-1.1-6.8:**

**(1) Except for an injury that is a direct result of a landowner's gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct, the landowner is immune from civil liability for any injury occurring to the health, life, or property of an invitee or a**

family member during the time the invitee or family member is present on the landowner's property.

**(2) Except for an injury that is a direct result of a guide's gross negligence or willful and wanton misconduct, a person guiding an invitee or a family member to the cemetery is immune from civil liability for any injury occurring to the health, life, or property of the invitee or family member during the time the guide and the invitee or family member are present on the landowner's property."**

Page 2, delete lines 1 through 12.

Page 2, line 13, delete "IC 34-30-2-158" and insert "IC 34-30-2-55.8".

Page 2, line 15, delete "158. IC 6-1.1-6.8-16" and insert "**55.8. IC 14-21-5-4**".

Page 2, line 17, delete "IC 6-1.1-6.8-15)." and insert "**IC 14-21-5**).".

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
