Synopsis: Statewide bid for emergency services equipment. Requires the department of administration to award quantity purchase agreements for the purchase of emergency services equipment.

HOUSE BILL No. 1052

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 4-13-1-25 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2012]: **Sec. 25. (a) As used in this section, "emergency services
4 equipment" refers to the following:**
5 (1) **Fire trucks.**
6 (2) **Emergency service vehicles.**
7 (3) **Firefighting tools.**
8 (4) **Protective wear.**
9 (5) **Breathing apparatuses.**
10 (6) **Communication devices, including hand held devices and
11 vehicle radios.**
12 (7) **Similar products used by public safety service providers.**
13 (b) **As used in this section, "public safety service provider" has
14 the meaning set forth in IC 10-19-9-2.**
15 (c) **As used in this section, "purchaser" includes the following:**
16 (1) **A political subdivision.**
17 (2) **A fire department established under IC 36-8-2-3.**

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- 1 **(3) A volunteer fire department (as defined in IC 36-8-12-2).**
- 2 **(4) The board of fire trustees of a fire protection district**
- 3 **established under IC 36-8-11.**
- 4 **(5) The provider unit of a fire protection territory established**
- 5 **under IC 36-8-19.**
- 6 **(6) A law enforcement agency of a political subdivision.**
- 7 **(7) An emergency medical services agency of a political**
- 8 **subdivision.**
- 9 **(d) The department shall award quantity purchase agreements**
- 10 **under IC 5-22 to vendors for the purchase of emergency services**
- 11 **equipment.**
- 12 **(e) A quantity purchase agreement awarded under this section**
- 13 **must require the vendor to offer to purchasers emergency services**
- 14 **equipment under the quantity purchase agreement.**
- 15 **(f) Purchasers may participate in the solicitation of purchase of**
- 16 **emergency services equipment. To participate in the solicitation of**
- 17 **emergency services equipment, a purchaser must do the following:**
- 18 **(1) Submit estimated quantities to the department.**
- 19 **(2) Commit to purchasing the minimum fill percentage**
- 20 **submitted for solicitation.**
- 21 **(g) The department may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 for**
- 22 **management and control of the process by which purchasers may**
- 23 **purchase emergency services equipment under this section.**

"(6) A law enforcement agency of a political subdivision.

(7) An emergency medical services agency of a political subdivision."
