**Citations Affected:** IC 10-17.

**Synopsis:** Military family relief fund. Extends from one year to three years the time that a service member or a service member's dependent may be eligible to receive assistance from the military family relief fund.

**Effective:** July 1, 2012.

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## HOUSE BILL No. 1059

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning military and veterans.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 10-17-12-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.113-2010,  
2 SECTION 77, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 8. (a) The military family relief fund is established  
4 to provide assistance with food, housing, utilities, medical services,  
5 basic transportation, child care, education, employment or workforce,  
6 and other essential family support expenses that have become difficult  
7 to afford for qualified service members or dependents of qualified  
8 service members.  
9 (b) Except as provided in section 9 of this chapter, the commission  
10 shall expend the money in the fund exclusively to provide grants for  
11 assistance as described in subsection (a).  
12 (c) A qualified service member or the qualified service member's  
13 dependent may be eligible to receive assistance from the fund for up to  
14 ~~one (1) year~~ **three (3) years** after the earlier of the following:  
15 (1) The date the qualified service member's active duty service  
16 ends.  
17 (2) The date, as established by presidential proclamation or by

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1 law, of the cessation of the national conflict or war with respect  
2 to which the qualified service member is eligible to receive  
3 assistance under section 7.5(3)(B) of this chapter.  
4 (d) The commission shall administer the fund.
