HOUSE BILL No. 1136

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 12-17.2-2.5-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.126-2007,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. The division shall establish a child care
4 advisory committee for each of the following categories of child care:
5 (1) Child care homes.
6 (2) Child care centers.
7 (3) **Child care ministries.**
