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## SENATE BILL No. 155

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DIGEST OF SB 155 (Updated January 24, 2012 2:45 pm - DI 102)

**Citations Affected:** IC 21-38.

**Synopsis:** Higher education employment age limits. Provides that the board of trustees of a state educational institution may not impose or allow any mandatory or presumptive age limits in the hiring, the retention in a position, or continuation of employment of any officers, faculty, or counsel of the institution. Excludes a: (1) fire department established by; or (2) police officer appointed by; the board of trustees of a state educational institution.

**Effective:** Upon passage.

## SENATE BILL No. 155

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1           SECTION 1. IC 21-38-3-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.2-2007, SECTION  
2 279, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON  
3 PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. (a) This section applies to the board of trustees of  
4 the following state educational institutions:  
5           (1) Ball State University.  
6           (2) Indiana University.  
7           (3) Indiana State University.  
8           (4) Purdue University.  
9           (5) University of Southern Indiana.  
10          (b) The board of trustees of a state educational institution may  
11 employ:  
12           (1) officers;  
13           (2) faculty;  
14           (3) employees;  
15           (4) consultants; and  
16           (5) counsel;  
17 necessary or convenient to aid in the formulation and implementation

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1 of the state educational institution's policies and to execute the will of  
2 the board of trustees within its particular institution.  
3 **(c) This subsection does not apply to a:**  
4 **(1) fire department established; or**  
5 **(2) police officer appointed;**  
6 **by the board of trustees of a state educational institution. The**  
7 **board of trustees may not impose or allow any mandatory or**  
8 **presumptive age limits in the hiring, the retention in a position, or**  
9 **the continuation of employment of any employee of the institution**  
10 **described under subsection (b)(1), (b)(2), or (b)(5).**  
11 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
