1 (c) If a recreation board is established under subsection ~~(b)~~;  
2 **(b)(2)(B)**, it must consist of five (5) resident freeholders appointed by  
3 the city executive or the town legislative body. At least one (1) member  
4 must be a member of the governing body of the school corporation and  
5 no members may serve on the municipal legislative body. All members  
6 must be qualified by an interest in and knowledge of the social and  
7 educational value of recreation. The members serve without  
8 compensation. The members shall be appointed for four (4) year terms  
9 from January 1 of the year of their appointment or until their successors  
10 are appointed. The initial terms of board members, however, are as  
11 follows:

- 12 (1) One (1) for a term of one (1) year.
- 13 (2) One (1) for a term of two (2) years.
- 14 (3) One (1) for a term of three (3) years.
- 15 (4) Two (2) for terms of four (4) years.

16 A vacancy shall be filled by the appointing authority for the remainder  
17 of the unexpired term.

18 (d) The park authority shall manage all public parks, including  
19 approaches, that belong to the municipality.

20 (e) If a municipality decides, by ordinance, to establish, lay out, or  
21 improve a public park or grounds, or to make an extension of a park or  
22 grounds, it may locate the park or grounds, including appurtenances,  
23 and it may lay out and open the public ways necessary for the  
24 improvement. If it is necessary to acquire land, water rights, or  
25 easements, or a pool, lake, or natural stream of water, the park authority  
26 may condemn that property and take possession of it if it is located  
27 within five (5) miles of the municipality. Before the park authority  
28 condemns the property, it shall assess the damages to the owners of the  
29 property at a meeting of the authority. Additional condemnation  
30 proceedings are the same as those provided for the taking of property  
31 to open streets.

32 (f) The park authority may adopt rules concerning the laying out,  
33 improvement, preservation, ornamentation, and management of parks.  
34 The park authority shall allow monuments or buildings for libraries,  
35 works of art, or historical collections to be erected in a park, as long as  
36 they are under the control of the persons in charge of the park and no  
37 inclosure separates them from the rest of the park.

38 (g) The legislative body of the municipality may also levy a tax on

1 all taxable property in the municipality to pay for park property and for  
2 its improvement. The legislative body may also borrow money and  
3 issue the bonds of the municipality at any rate of interest payable  
4 annually or semiannually and may sell them for at least par value. The  
5 money derived from the sale of bonds may be used only for the  
6 purchase or improvement of parks. The legislative body shall annually  
7 levy a tax sufficient to pay the interest on the debt on all taxable  
8 property in the municipality to create a sinking fund for the liquidation  
9 of the principal of the debt.

10 (h) If the park authority of a city decides to lease any buildings or  
11 grounds belonging to the city and located in a public park when they  
12 are not required for public use, the proceeds shall be deposited with the  
13 city fiscal officer to the credit of park funds and devoted to the  
14 improvement of public parks.

15 (i) Any nonreverting fund that was created under IC 19-7-6 (before  
16 its repeal on September 1, 1981) continues until abolished by ordinance  
17 of the municipal legislative body. The legislative body may include in  
18 the park authority's annual budget an item and an appropriation for the  
19 specific purposes of a nonreverting capital fund. Money put in the fund  
20 may not be withdrawn except for the purposes for which the fund was  
21 created, unless the legislative body repeals the ordinance creating the  
22 fund. The repeal may not be made under suspension of the rules.  
23 Money procured from fees shall be deposited at least once each month  
24 with the municipal fiscal officer. The fiscal officer shall deposit the  
25 money either in a special nonreverting operating fund or in the  
26 nonreverting capital fund as directed by the park authority. The  
27 legislative body may provide by ordinance that expenditures may be  
28 made from the special nonreverting operating fund without  
29 appropriation. Money from fees procured from golf courses, swimming  
30 pools, skating rinks, or other similar facilities requiring major  
31 expenditures for management and maintenance may not be deposited  
32 in this fund. Money from either fund shall be disbursed only on  
33 approved claims that are allowed and signed in the same manner as
