SENATE BILL No. 187



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-42-8-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 1. The maximum fee
3 of a notary public is ~~two~~ **four** dollars (~~\$2~~) (**\$4**) for each notarial act.
