## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Synopsis:** Common core state standards. Provides that the state board of education may not adopt as standards for the state any common core standards developed by the Common Core State Standards Initiative. Voids any action taken to adopt common core standards.

**Effective:** July 1, 2012.

# SENATE BILL No. 373



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-2-14.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA  
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS  
3 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: **Sec. 14.5. (a) Notwithstanding section**  
4 **14 of this chapter, the state board may not adopt as standards for**  
5 **the state or direct the department to implement any common core**  
6 **standards developed by the Common Core State Standards**  
7 **Initiative.**  
8 **(b) After June 30, 2012, any action taken by the state board**  
9 **before July 1, 2012, to adopt common core standards as standards**  
10 **for the state is void.**
