

# HOUSE BILL No. 1017

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** None (noncode).

**Synopsis:** Greene County local public question on zoning ordinance. Requires the Greene County election board to place on the November 2012 general election ballot a nonbinding local public question concerning the establishment of land use planning and zoning in Greene County.

**Effective:** July 1, 2012.

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January 9, 2012, read first time and referred to Committee on Elections and Apportionment.

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## HOUSE BILL No. 1017



A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning elections.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012] (a) The Greene County
- 2 election board shall place the following nonbinding local public
- 3 question on the ballot prepared for the voters of the county at the
- 4 November 2012 general election:
- 5 "Are you in favor of zoning ordinance #2012-1?".
- 6 (b) The county election board shall tabulate the votes cast on the
- 7 public question described in this SECTION and certify the results
- 8 under IC 3-12-4-9. The circuit court clerk shall send a copy of the
- 9 certification required by this subsection to the county legislative
- 10 body and the county advisory plan commission.
- 11 (c) IC 3 applies to the local public question placed on the ballot
- 12 under this SECTION to the extent IC 3 is not inconsistent with this
- 13 SECTION.
- 14 (d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2013.
