

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 10 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, between the enacting clause and line 1, begin a new
2 paragraph and insert:
3 "SECTION 1. IC 25-4.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
4 A NEW ARTICLE TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
5 2012]:
6 **ARTICLE 4.5. ART THERAPISTS**
7 **Chapter 1. Activity by Nonregistered Art Therapists**
8 **Sec. 1. As used in this article, "art therapy" means the use of the**
9 **creative process, visual art media, and psychotherapeutic**
10 **principles within the therapeutic relationship with a patient in the**
11 **assessment and treatment of emotional, cognitive, psychosocial,**
12 **physical, neurological, and developmental disorders in children,**
13 **adolescents, adults, families, and other groups.**
14 **Sec. 2. (a) As used in the section, "practitioner" means a person**
15 **that holds:**
16 **(1) an unlimited license, certificate, registration, or permit;**
17 **(2) a limited or probationary license, certificate, registration,**
18 **or permit;**
19 **(3) a temporary license, certificate, registration, or permit; or**
20 **(4) an intern permit;**
21 **issued by a board regulating a profession or an occupation.**
22 **(b) This chapter does not prohibit a practitioner from**
23 **performing art therapy functions if the practitioner is acting**
24 **within the scope of the practitioner's license, permit, registration,**
25 **or certificate.**
26 **Sec. 3. Except as provided in section 2 of this chapter, an**
27 **individual may not:**
28 **(1) profess to be a registered art therapist or art therapist;**
29 **(2) use the initials "ATR", or any other words, letters,**
30 **abbreviations, or insignia indicating or implying that the**

1 **individual is a registered art therapist; or**
 2 **(3) practice art therapy;**
 3 **unless the individual holds and maintains the registration**
 4 **credentialing administered by the Art Therapy Credentials Board.**

5 **Sec. 4. An individual who knowingly, recklessly, or intentionally**
 6 **violates section 3 of this chapter commits a Class B misdemeanor."**

7 Page 6, after line 2, begin a new paragraph and insert:

8 "SECTION 15. IC 35-51-25-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.70-2011,
 9 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
