MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Engrossed House Bill 1002 be amended to read as follows:

22 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
23 JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 3. A taxpayer (as defined in the following laws),
24 pass through entity (as defined in the following laws), or shareholder,
25 partner, or member of a pass through entity may not be granted more
26 than one (1) tax credit under the following laws for the same project:

- 27 (1) IC 6-3.1-10 (enterprise zone investment cost credit).
- 28 (2) IC 6-3.1-11 (industrial recovery tax credit).
- 29 (3) IC 6-3.1-11.5 (military base recovery tax credit).
- 30 (4) IC 6-3.1-11.6 (military base investment cost credit).
- 31 (5) IC 6-3.1-13.5 (capital investment tax credit) **(before its**
- 32 **expiration on January 1, 2020).**
- 33 (6) IC 6-3.1-19 (community revitalization enhancement district
- 34 tax credit).
- 35 (7) IC 6-3.1-24 (venture capital investment tax credit).
- 36 (8) IC 6-3.1-26 (Hoosier business investment tax credit).
- 37 (9) IC 6-3.1-31.9 (Hoosier alternative fuel vehicle manufacturer
- 38 tax credit).

39 If a taxpayer, pass through entity, or shareholder, partner, or member
40 of a pass through entity has been granted more than one (1) tax credit
41 for the same project, the taxpayer, pass through entity, or shareholder,
42 partner, or member of a pass through entity must elect to apply only
43 one (1) of the tax credits in the manner and form prescribed by the
44 department."

45 Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
