

SENATE MOTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 280 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Delete the title and insert the following:
2 A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning
3 education and to make an appropriation.
4 Page 11, between lines 38 and 39, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5 "SECTION 11. IC 20-33-2-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.43-2009,
6 SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) Each public school shall and each
8 private school may require a student who initially enrolls in the school
9 to provide:
10 (1) the name and address of the school the student last attended;
11 and
12 (2) a certified copy of the student's birth certificate or other
13 reliable proof of the student's date of birth.
14 (b) Not more than fourteen (14) days after initial enrollment in a
15 school, the school shall request the student's records from the school
16 the student last attended.
17 (c) If the document described in subsection (a)(2):
18 (1) is not provided to the school not more than thirty (30) days
19 after the student's enrollment; or
20 (2) appears to be inaccurate or fraudulent;
21 the school shall notify the Indiana clearinghouse for information on
22 missing children and missing endangered adults established under
23 IC 10-13-5-5 and determine if the student has been reported missing.
24 (d) A school in Indiana receiving a request for records shall send the
25 records promptly to the requesting school. **An accredited nonpublic**
26 **school is required to send a former student's records that are**
27 **requested under subsection (b) regardless of whether the former**
28 **student of the accredited nonpublic school or the former student's**
29 **parent or guardian owes an outstanding debt to the accredited**
30 **nonpublic school. However,** If a request is received for records to

- 1 which a notice has been attached under IC 31-36-1-5 (or IC 31-6-13-6
- 2 before its repeal), the school:
- 3 (1) shall immediately notify the Indiana clearinghouse for
- 4 information on missing children and missing endangered adults;
- 5 (2) may not send the school records without the authorization of
- 6 the clearinghouse; and
- 7 (3) may not inform the requesting school that a notice under
- 8 IC 31-36-1-5 (or IC 31-6-13-6 before its repeal) has been attached
- 9 to the records.
- 10 **(e) The department may revoke the accreditation of an**
- 11 **accredited nonpublic school that does not send a former student's**
- 12 **records to a requesting school as required under subsection (d)."**
- 13 Page 31, after line 37, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 14 "SECTION 47. **An emergency is declared for this act.**".
- 15 Re-number all SECTIONS consecutively.
