DIGEST OF SB 249 (Updated January 18, 2012 11:40 am - DI 106)

Citations Affected: IC 31-11.

Synopsis: Record of marriage. Provides that a clerk of a circuit court: (1) may forward a record of marriage to the state department of health in a paper form or in an electronic form by using an automated system developed by the judicial technology and automation project or another automated system approved by the state department of health; and (2) who forwards a record of marriage to the state department of health in an electronic form is not required to forward the record of marriage to the state department of health in a paper form.

Effective: July 1, 2012.

SENATE BILL No. 249

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 31-11-4-18 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 18. (a) The clerk of the
3 circuit court shall forward **records of marriage records** to the state
4 department of health on at least a monthly basis. **A clerk:**
5 **(1) may forward a record of marriage to the state department**
6 **of health in:**
7 **(A) a paper form; or**
8 **(B) an electronic form by using:**
9 **(i) an automated system developed by the judicial**
10 **technology and automation project; or**
11 **(ii) another automated system approved by the state**
12 **department of health; and**
13 **(2) who forwards a record of marriage to the state**
14 **department of health in an electronic form is not required to**
15 **forward the record of marriage to the state department of**
16 **health in a paper form.**

- 1 (1) prescribe a form for recording marriages;
- 2 (2) accept a court order under section 17 of this chapter (or
- 3 IC 31-7-3-15.5 before its repeal) in place of a marriage certificate;
- 4 (3) prepare an annual index of all marriages solemnized in
- 5 Indiana and furnish at least one (1) index to the Indiana state
- 6 library; and
- 7 (4) furnish reports on records of marriage published by the state
- 8 department of health to the Indiana state library.
