SENATE BILL No. 268

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-19-4-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
2 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
3 2012]: Sec. 3. **(a)** The roundtable consists of the following members:
4 (1) A number of members appointed jointly by the governor and
5 the state superintendent. These members must be representatives
6 of:
7 (A) business and community leaders;
8 (B) elementary and secondary education, including programs
9 for exceptional learners (as defined in IC 20-31-2-6); and
10 (C) higher education.
11 The number of members appointed under clause (A) must be
12 equal to the number of members appointed under clauses (B) and
13 (C).
14 (2) Two (2) members appointed by the president pro tempore of
15 the senate from different political parties.
16 (3) Two (2) members appointed by the speaker of the house of
17 representatives from different political parties.

1 **(b) The roundtable shall create an advisory committee on early**
2 **childhood education. The members of the advisory committee must**
3 **be early childhood education leaders from around the state. The**
4 **advisory committee shall provide professional and technical**
5 **assistance concerning topics related to early childhood education**
6 **to the roundtable.**

7 SECTION 2. IC 20-19-4-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.1-2005, SECTION
8 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1,
9 2012]: Sec. 4. (a) A member of the roundtable **or the advisory**
10 **committee on early childhood education** is not entitled to a salary per
11 diem.

12 (b) A member of the roundtable **or the advisory committee on**
13 **early childhood education** is entitled to reimbursement for traveling
14 expenses and other expenses actually incurred in connection with the
15 member's duties, as provided in the state travel policies and procedures
16 established by the Indiana department of administration and approved
17 by the budget agency.
