

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Local Government, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 309, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 8, after line 9, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 6. IC 36-9-15-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
3 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. (a) A county
4 fiscal body may establish cumulative building funds under IC 6-1.1-41
5 or sinking funds in the same manner as cumulative funds are
6 established under IC 6-1.1-41 for the:
7 (1) construction, repair, remodeling, enlarging, and equipment of:
8 (A) a county jail; or
9 (B) a juvenile detention center to be operated under
10 IC 31-31-9;
11 **(2) purchase, lease, or payment of all or part of the purchase**
12 **price of motor vehicles for the use of a community corrections**
13 **program; or**
14 ~~(2)~~ **(3)** in a county having a consolidated city, purchase, lease, or
15 payment of all or part of the purchase price of motor vehicles for
16 **the** use of the sheriff's department.
17 (b) The county fiscal body may levy taxes to provide money for:
18 (1) cumulative building funds established under this chapter in
19 compliance with IC 6-1.1-41; or
20 (2) sinking funds established under this chapter in the same
21 manner a tax is levied for a cumulative fund under IC 6-1.1-41.

1 (c) IC 6-1.1-41 applies to a sinking fund under this chapter to the
2 same extent as if the sinking fund was a cumulative fund.

3 SECTION 7. IC 36-9-16-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.34-2010,
4 SECTION 10, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
5 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 3. A unit may establish cumulative capital
6 improvement funds to provide money for one (1) or more of the
7 following purposes:

8 (1) To acquire land or rights-of-way to be used for public ways or
9 sidewalks.

10 (2) To construct and maintain public ways or sidewalks.

11 (3) To acquire land or rights-of-way for the construction of
12 sanitary or storm sewers, or both.

13 (4) To construct and maintain sanitary or storm sewers, or both.

14 (5) To acquire, by purchase or lease, or to pay all or part of the
15 purchase price of a utility.

16 (6) To purchase or lease land, buildings, or rights-of-way for the
17 use of any utility that is acquired or operated by the unit.

18 (7) To purchase or acquire land, with or without buildings, for
19 park or recreation purposes.

20 (8) To purchase, lease, or pay all or part of the purchase price of
21 motor vehicles for the use of **any combination of the police, a**
22 **community corrections program, or the fire department, or**
23 ~~both~~, including ambulances and firefighting vehicles with the
24 necessary equipment, ladders, and hoses.

25 (9) To retire in whole or in part any general obligation bonds of
26 the unit that were issued for the purpose of acquiring or
27 constructing improvements or properties that would qualify for
28 the use of cumulative capital improvement funds.

29 (10) To purchase or lease equipment and other nonconsumable
30 personal property needed by the unit for any public transportation
31 use.

32 (11) In a county or a consolidated city, to purchase or lease
33 equipment to be used to illuminate a public way or sidewalk.

34 (12) The fund may be used for any of the following purposes:

35 (A) To purchase, lease, upgrade, maintain, or repair one (1) or
36 more of the following:

37 (i) Computer hardware.

38 (ii) Computer software.

39 (iii) Wiring and computer networks.

40 (iv) Communication access systems used to connect with
41 computer networks or electronic gateways.

42 (B) To pay for the services of full-time or part-time computer

- 1 maintenance employees.
- 2 (C) To conduct nonrecurring inservice technology training of
- 3 unit employees.
- 4 (13) To purchase body armor (as defined in IC 35-47-5-13(a)) for
- 5 active members of a police department under:
- 6 (A) IC 36-5-7-7;
- 7 (B) IC 36-8-4-4.5;
- 8 (C) IC 36-8-9-9; and
- 9 (D) IC 36-8-10-4.5.
- 10 **SECTION 8. An emergency is declared for this act."**
- 11 **Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.**
(Reference is to SB 309 as introduced.)
