

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 407, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 2, line 4, after "times." insert "**A pharmacist may not**
2 **supervise more than six (6) pharmacy technicians or pharmacy**
3 **technicians in training at any time.**"
- 4 Page 2, line 4, strike "clause," and insert "**subdivision,**".
- 5 Page 2, delete lines 34 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
6 insert:
- 7 "SECTION 2. IC 25-26-19-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
8 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012]: Sec. 5. (a) The board shall
9 issue a pharmacy technician certificate to an individual who:
- 10 (1) applies to the board in the form and manner prescribed by the
11 board;
- 12 (2) is at least eighteen (18) years of age;
- 13 (3) has not been convicted of:
- 14 **(A) a crime that has a direct bearing upon the individual's**
15 **ability to practice competently; or**
- 16 **(B) a felony involving controlled substances;**
- 17 (4) is not in violation of this chapter or rules adopted by the board
18 under section 4 of this chapter;
- 19 (5) has paid the fee set by the board under section 4 of this
20 chapter; and
- 21 (6) has completed a program of education and training approved

- 1 by the board or has passed a certification examination offered by
- 2 a nationally recognized certification body approved by the board.
- 3 (b) For good cause, the board may waive the age requirement under
- 4 subsection (a)(2)."
- 5 Delete page 3.
- 6 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
 (Reference is to SB 407 as introduced.)

and when so amended that said bill do pass .
