

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Elections, to which was referred House Bill No. 1004, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 3, between lines 15 and 16, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 3. IC 3-11-4-17, AS AMENDED BY P.L.198-2005,
3 SECTION 6, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 17. Upon receipt of an application for an
5 absentee ballot, a circuit court clerk shall file the application in the
6 clerk's office and record all of the following **in the statewide voter**
7 **registration list maintained under IC 3-7-26.3:**
8 (1) The voter's name.
9 (2) The date the application is received.
10 (3) The date the ballot is sent to the voter.
11 (4) If mailed, the address to which the ballot is sent.
12 (5) If transmitted by fax, the fax number to which the ballot is
13 faxed.
14 (6) The date the ballot is marked before the clerk or otherwise
15 received from the voter.
16 (7) The combined total number of absentee ballots sent by the
17 county to absent uniformed services voters and overseas voters.
18 (8) The total number of absentee ballots returned by voters
19 described in subdivision (7) in time to be counted.
20 (9) The total number of absentee ballots described in subdivision

- 1 (7) that were counted in whole or in part.
- 2 (10) Any other information that is necessary or advisable."
- 3 Page 4, line 18, after "appointed" delete ",".
- 4 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
