

# COMMITTEE REPORT

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## MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Energy and Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 133, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 3, line 14, delete "chapter:" and insert "**chapter as follows:**".
- 2 Page 3, line 15, delete "if" and insert "**If**".
- 3 Page 3, line 20, delete "prevention; or" and insert "**prevention.**".
- 4 Page 3, line 21, delete "after providing:" and insert "**If the owner or**
- 5 **operator fails**".
- 6 Page 3, delete line 22.
- 7 Page 3, run in lines 21 through 23.
- 8 Page 3, delete lines 25 through 27 and insert "**prevention. The**
- 9 **commissioner must give the owner or operator:**
- 10 (i) a written warning; and
- 11 (ii) at least thirty (30) days to take corrective action to
- 12 bring the underground storage tank into compliance.
- 13 (C) If the owner or operator fails to register an
- 14 underground petroleum storage tank or pay annual
- 15 registration fees that are due under IC 13-23-12. The

1 **commissioner must give the owner or operator at least thirty (30)**  
2 **days to take corrective action to bring the underground storage**  
3 **tank into compliance."**

(Reference is to SB 133 as introduced.)
